(1) Unplug the power. (2) Place the Heated Tub outside in the cold (if temperatures are below freezing) for approximately 45 minutes to re-set the thermostat. (3) After 45 minutes, immediately plug unit into a receptacle outlet. (4) If working properly, the heating element will warm up right away. Within a minute the thermostat should "click" off. The tub is operating correctly.
