NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN	
Contains the nerve poison bromethalin. This product is not an anticoagulant type rodenticide. For humans or animals ingesting bait and/or showing poisoning signs (such as muscle tremors, loss of hind limb use, or seizures for animals), limit absorption by either emesis or gastric lavage. Sublethal symptoms, if present, would be the result of cerebral edema and should be treated accordingly through administration of an osmotic diuretic and corticosteroid.	

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Keep away from children, domestic animals and pets. Any person who retrieves carcasses or unused bait following application of this product must wear waterproof gloves.

USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS: As soon as possible, wash hands thoroughly after applying bait and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Dogs, cats and other predatory and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten this bait. Do not apply directly to water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions. Use only for the sites, pests and application methods described on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS:

This bait station may be used in areas accessible to children and pets, consistent with all use restrictions and other requirements indicated on this label. Do not apply further than 50 feet from home or building.

For control only of house mice. This bait station can only be refilled with the block bait sold with this station. TOMCAT® MOUSE KILLER I must be used in and around buildings consistent with all use restrictions and other requirements indicated on this label. Do not place this bait station or stored block bait in any area where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come into direct contact with food. Store block bait refills out of reach of children and pets.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where house mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

While wearing waterproof gloves, place one block of bait in the bait station. See additional GRAPHICS AND TEXT. Place the bait station at point of highest activity along a wall or in corner where signs of house mice have been seen. If additional units are to be used, place bait stations at 8- to 12-foot intervals. While wearing waterproof gloves, replace bait in bait station if bait is consumed or contaminated and house mice still are using the bait station. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until there no longer are fresh signs of house mouse activity in infested areas. Note: Mice will eat a small amount of bait and cease feeding after consuming a toxic dose. They then leave the station. You likely will not find a dead mouse in the station.

Follow-up: Wearing waterproof gloves, collect and properly dispose of any leftover bait or carcasses. To discourage reinfestation, eliminate food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store only in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Nonrefillable Container. Do not reuse or refill container except as described in the Directions For Use.

If Empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
