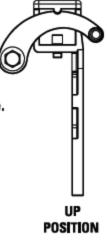
## TO RAISE LOAD

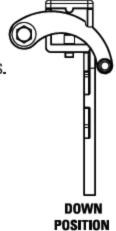
- Place the foot of the jack securely beneath the load.
- Lift the reversing latch to its UP position and ensure it is locked in place.
- Jack the nose up until it comes in contact with load.
- Check to ensure nothing will obstruct a clean lift.
- Pull down firmly and steadily on handle to raise load. The climbing pin will "click."
- Relax handle allowing pin to support load.
- Raise handle to the top of its stroke and pull again.



IMPORTANT: THE JACK MUST BE LOADED WITH A MINIMUM OF 110 LBS. TO LOWER STEP BY STEP, OTHERWISE THE LIFTING NOSE WILL DROP.

- Jack the load up slightly and ensure handle is in its fully upright position.
- Trip the reversing latch so that it is in the DOWN position.
- Keeping a firm grip on the handle, steadily pump just as you would to raise a load.
