


- (2) Ladders

- Feeder (1 Gallon)








# Assembly Instructions:

- 1. Attach cap to Feeder first by firmly pressing tabs onto outside of Feeder (it is easiest to do the outer snaps first, then work toward the center).
- 2. Pre-Bend Ladders at hinge points along sides Note: Make sure ladders is bent so that the ridge along top is opening to the outside. (See detail drawing below).
- 3. Fold to create rectangle.
- 4. Firmly snap clips on edge together to secure. This may be easier if the ladder is laid flat. Snap the center clip first, and work outward.
- 5. Push ladders into cap until seated securely (the flange of the ladder will lay flush on the cap when seated completely).









Note: When folded properly, flange on top of ladder should be on outside to create a shelf that will prevent ladder from falling into opening in cap.




- a. Feeder Cap & Ladder
  b. Feeder (1 Gallon)


### Assembly Instructions:


- 1. Unfold right ladder then left ladder.
- 2. Bend ladder sides upwards (Image #2 below).
- 3. Fold ladders down.
- 4. Push cap into feeder.
