
Important: Product intended for use in traditional framing and drywall construction. For brick installation, or other thick wall construction, you may need additional extension pieces, available from PetSafe®.






Step Measure and Cut Wall Access


- Locate the site for your SmartDoor™ Wall Entry installation and verify accessibility for your pet both inside and outside. Note: Check both indoors and outdoors for electrical wiring or pipes in the wall area in which you wish to install the Pet Door. If necessary, cut a small hole in the wall to verify the stud location and that no wiring or plumbing exists.
- 2. Locate the edge of one stud in the proposed area with a stud finder. Using a pencil, draw a 5" vertical line on the edge of the stud about 10" to 12" above the floor (1A).
- 3. Mark the shoulder height of your pet on the vertical line. Draw a horizontal line through your mark (1B).
- 4. Cut template to size $(14 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 22 $\frac{3}{4}$ ") and place against the wall aligning the shoulder height line on the template with shoulder height line on the wall. Align the edge of the template to the 5" vertical line. Make sure your template is placed on the proper edge of the stud, not over the stud (1C, 1D).
- 5. Carefully trace the template with a pencil (1E). Remove the template from the wall.














- 6. Take a moment to review the hole location to ensure that the template is level and that this is the best possible location for the Pet Door. Keep in mind you are cutting a hole from the inside edge of one stud to the inside edge of its neighboring stud. In common framing, this space should measure about 14 ½.
- 7. Drill the 4 corners all the way through the inside and outer walls. Use a ⁵/₁₆" drill bit, and use the framing square to be sure you keep the drill level and perpendicular to the wall (1F).
- 8. Carefully cut the hole out using a jigsaw or other appropriate cutting device (1G).
 - Note: Cut on line.
- 9. Move outdoors and repeat using the previously drilled holes as your corners. Always check that your lines are plumb (vertical) and level (horizontal). Remember to measure frequently, so you only need to cut once.






Install Supports


- 1. Measure from the inside of outer wall to the inside of inner wall as shown to determine stud thickness (2A).
- 2. Cut a 2" x 4" or 2" x 6" piece to the width of the opening, making sure that the cut is square.
- 3. Remove any debris that may be inside the wall where the supports will be located.






- 4. Place support inside wall so that the top of support is flush with the bottom of cut-out.
- 5. Use 2 decking screws to fasten the inner side of each support as shown (2B). Check again to make sure that the supports are flush with bottom of cut-out (2B).
- 6. Move outdoors. Use 2 decking screws to fasten the outer edges of the supports (2C).

Note: If placing screws into vinyl siding it may be necessary to drill a hole through the siding slightly larger than the heads of the screws. This will allow the screws to tighten flush with plywood and not buckle the vinyl siding.



Step Attach the SmartDoor™ to the **Extension Tunnel**


- 1. Insert the Electronic SmartDoor™ into the lip of the Tunnel Extension as shown (3A-1).
- 2. Tape the Tunnel Extension to the Electronic SmartDoor[™] (3A-2). Note: Rear Door Frame of SmartDoor™ will not be used in wall installation.



Step

Install the Assemblies into the Wall

- 1. From outside the home, insert the Outside Frame into the wall. Check for plumb (vertical) and level (horizontal) before installing any screws.
- 2. Have a helper hold the frame in place while you work indoors.
- 3. Insert the Electronic SmartDoor™ and Tunnel Extension assembly from inside the home. Check that the assembly is flush to the wall. Check for plumb and level before installing any screws.
- 4. Beginning indoors, install the 6 Phillips head wood screws through the SmartDoor™ into the wall, and into the 2" x 4" or 2" x 6" bracing installed earlier. Avoid overtightening the screws.
- Moving outdoors, drill holes and install 4 Phillips head wood screws, one in each corner of the outside frame. These screws should pass through the frame, the wall, and fasten into the framing studs on either
 - side of the framed tunnel. Avoid overtightening the screws. Note: Wall construction may be different from that shown and therefore require the installer to improvise, using the appropriate tools and hardware.
- 6. Install additional wood screws around the frame, securing it flush to the wall. Exterior wall materials will vary; please avoid overtightening these screws.
- 7. Use window caulking to fill in any seams and gaps in your installation.





Step Install Batteries and Begin Training

Refer to the operating instructions that accompanied your Electronic SmartDoor $^{\text{\tiny{TM}}}$ purchase for detailed instructions on operating your door, and training your pet.

REGISTERING THE PRODUCT: Within thirty (30) days of purchase, please go to www.petsafe.net to register your purchase. You may be required to provide proof of purchase to obtain warranty coverage. Please keep this information in a safe place.

Pursuant to this non-transferrable limited warranty, PetSafe® will replace the part with a new or refurbished part. This non-transferrable limited warranty will then apply to either the new or refurbished part for the remainder of the original non-transferrable limited warranty period.

EXCLUSIONS: REPLACEMENT AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS NON-TRANSFERRABLE LIMITED WARRANTY IS THE EXCLUSIVE REMEDY OF THE CONSUMER, NEITHER LABOR TO REMOVE THE PART NOR LABOR TO INSTALL THE REFURBISHED OR REPLACED PART IS COVERED.

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GOVERNING LAW: This non-transferrable limited warranty shall be governed by the law of the State of Tennessee, U.S.A., and by the laws of the United States of America, excluding their conflicts of laws principles.
