Creates an air- and water-tight seal that won't leak, crack, or split. Use to install and maintain direct vent appliances, gas-burning systems, pellet stoves, and metal flues on wood- and coal-burning stoves. Not an adhesive. It is easily removed for cleaning and inspection.

Surface Prep: Surface should be clean, dry, and free of rust, dirt, grease, oil, or any contamination that might interfere with adhesion. If grease or oil is present, clean surface with acetone.

Application: Cut the tip of the tube or cartridge. Insert cartridges in a caulking gun. Extrude a bead of about ½ inch on the area to be sealed. Cure 24 to 48 hours before exposure to heat.

Coverage: Approximately 6 feet for 10.3oz and 1.3 feet for 2.3oz using a ½" bead.

Clean up: Wash hands and tools with water within 15 minutes. Dispose of unused or unwanted products following applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.
