## INSECTICIDE \& FERTILIZER SPRAYER

INSTRUCTIONS
1.1 The sprayer when used as packaged is set up for Tablespoon concentration( i.e. The screw in filter top of the dial remains as is ).

1.2 In this case if you were to set the dial to number 1 you would be the mixing 3 ml of insecticide or fertilizer per liter of water. Similarly, if so set the dial to number 2 you would be mixing 6 ml per liter of water. The chart below sets out the concentrations:

| Dial No | Mi per Litre |
| :--- | :--- |
| 1 | 3 |
| 2 | 6 |
| 3 | 9 |
| 4 | 12 |
| 5 | 16 |
| 6 | 19 |
| 7 | 22 |
| 10 | 31 |

2.1 In order to reduce flow to Teaspoon concentration, unscrew the gold filter in the top of the dial and push it into the tube.


2.2 This reduces the flow through the Sprayer. In this case if the dial is set number 1 you are using 1 ml of insecticide or sprayer per liter of water. The chart is as follows:

| Dial No |  |
| :---: | :---: |
| 1 | Mi per Litre |
| 2 | 1 |
| 3 | 2 |
| 4 | 3 |
| 5 | 4 |
| 6 | 6 |
| 7 | 7 |
| 10 | 10 |

The flow and concentration that you use will vary according to the directions on the insecticide/fertilizer that you purchase.
*** Remember to wash your Sprayer out thoroughly after each use***
