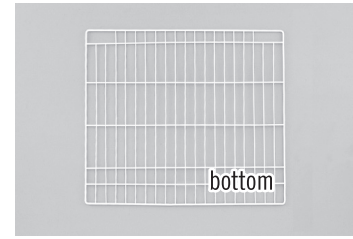
### PARTS • MAKE SURE ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT UPON ASSEMBLY



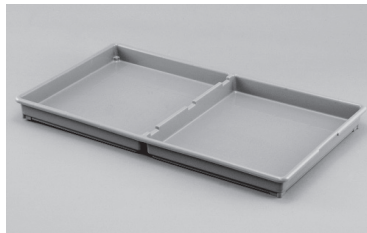
BASE (UPPER AND LOWER LATCHES, 2 EACH)



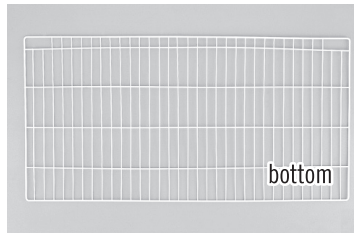
FRONT PANEL WITH DOOR (1)



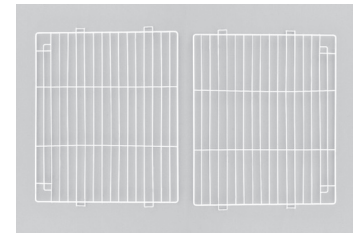
SIDE PANELS (2)

### MATERIALS

UPPER/LOWER TRAYS/FLOORS/JOINTS: POLYPROPYLENE

CORNER JOINTS: ABS RESIN

FENCING: STEEL WITH POWDER PAINT FINISH

### MAINTENANCE

- When cleaning the cage, use a soft cloth or sponge with mild detergent to wash and a soft cloth dry.
- Harsh cleansers, polishing powder or a scrubbing brush may cause scratches.

### WARNING

- Do not stand, sit or put things on the cage. Keep the product from children playing with it. It may cause an injury or accident or damage to the product.
- Place the cage on a flat surface.
- Pick up the cage by the base when moving the cage. The latches may come off if holding by anything other than the base, causing the cage to fall and cause injury or damage as a result.
- The pet's paws may get caught in-between the openings of the fence. Please take caution while in use.

### CAUTION

- Misuse can lead to injury to pet or owner & damage.
- The product is intended for use by small pets. Do not use for other than the intended purpose..
- Make sure that the door is completely closed by checking the lock. If the door is not completely closed, it may open and the pet may escape.
- Do not use for small pets that may be able to escape through the panels.
- Inquire at a pet shop or where you have purchased your pet for more information about how to care for the pet.

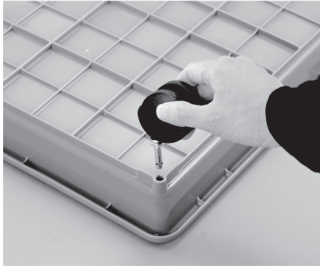

# ASSEMBLY

• ASSEMBLE ON FLAT SURFACE, WITH CARDBOARD UNDERNEATH TO AVOID SCRATCHING

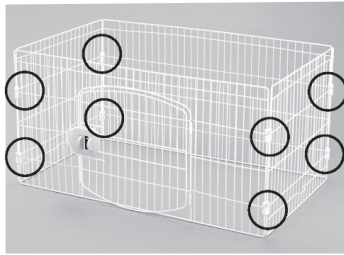
**1** Attach casters to base by pushing into hole.



**2** Secure base and lower tray using latches.

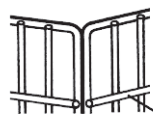


**3** Assemble front, back and side panels using circle joints. Horizontal bars of fence should be facing outward.



### ATTACHING

**1** bars outward



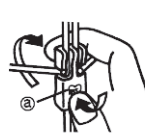
horizontal bars

**2** push onto vertical bars



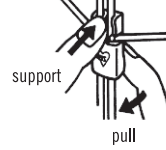
vertical bar

**3** press [a] into bars to lock



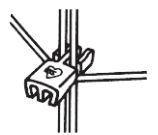
### DETACHING

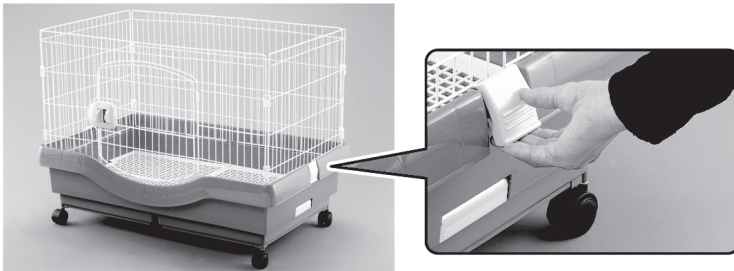

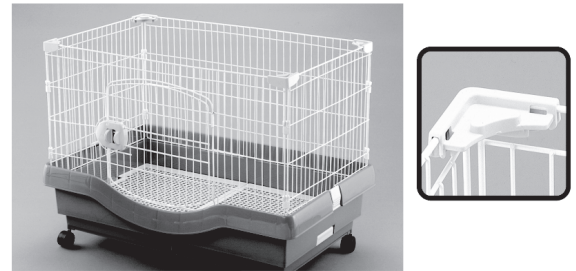
**3** support upper portion of joint, pull forward to detach



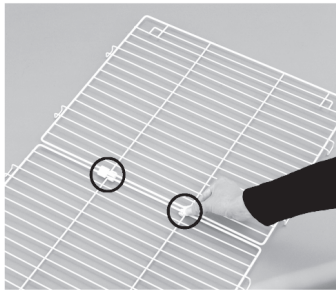
**4** Place side panels onto lower tray and secure latches (2 locations).



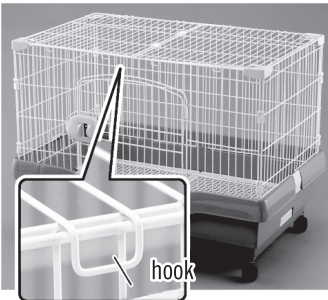
**5** Push and secure using corner joints (4 locations).



**6** 1. Secure top panels using circle joints (2 locations).

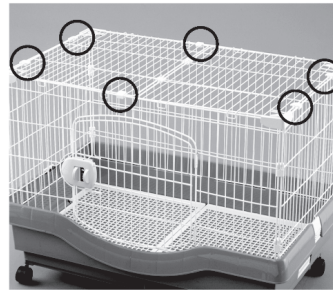


2. Place top panel hook on outside of front and back fences.

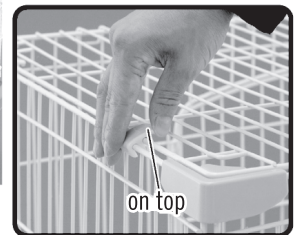

3. Place click joints at locations shown in photo (6 locations).



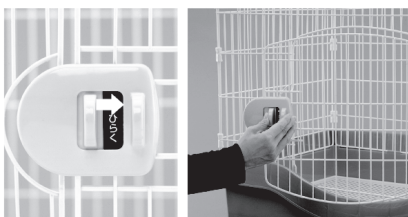
- Secure using click joints to places on top panel where there is no opening or closing (4 locations).
- Tabs of click joints should be placed inward of cage.



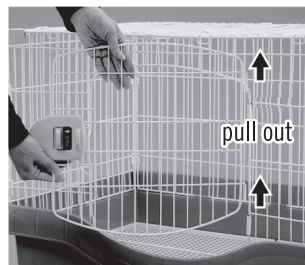

## OPENING/CLOSING FRONT DOOR

Pinch tabs on front door lock during opening.



## DETACHING FRONT DOOR



pull out

## OPENING/CLOSING TOP DOOR

Push tab of click joint upward to release.
