It must be understood by the operator that common sense and caution are factors which cannot be built into this product, but must be supplied by the operator.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

WORK AREA

- Keep the work area clean, free of clutter, and well-lit. Cluttered and dark work areas can cause accidents.
- **Keep children and bystanders** away while assembling or operating the timberjack. Distractions can cause you to lose control, so visitors should remain at a safe distance from the work area.
- Be aware of all power lines, electrical circuits, water pipes and other mechanical hazards in your work area, particularly those hazards below the work surface hidden from the operator's view that may be unintentionally contacted and may cause personal harm or property damage.
- **Be alert of your surroundings.** Using the timberjack in confined work areas may put you in a dangerous situation.

PERSONAL SAFETY

- Stay alert, watch what you are doing, and use common sense when using the timberjack. Do not use the timberjack while you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or medication. A moment of inattention while operating the timberjack may result in serious personal injury.
- Dress properly. Do not wear loose clothing, dangling objects, or jewelry. Keep your hair, clothing, and gloves away from moving parts. Loose clothes, jewelry, or long hair can be caught in moving parts.

TIMBERJACK USE AND CARE

- **Do not modify the timberjack in any way.** Unauthorized modification may impair the function and/or safety and could affect the life of the equipment.
- Always check for damaged or worn out parts before using the timberjack. Broken parts will
 affect the timberjack operation. Replace or repair damaged or worn parts immediately.
- · The timberjack is for OUTDOOR use ONLY.




- 1. **BE AWARE of side hills or steep inclines.** Operating on flat surfaces, such as small inclines or hills, can cause the timberjack to tip over or roll out of control.
- 2. DO NOT transport people or pets with the timberjack.

ASSEMBLY

Function 1: Cant Hook


Step 1: Attach the double hook with two teeth (#3) to the sleeve (#2) with a M10 \times 45 bolt (#13) and locknut (#15).



Function 2: Peavey

Step 1: Attach the double hook with two teeth (#3) to the sleeve (#2) with a M10 \times 45 bolt (#13) and locknut (#15).

Step 2: Assemble the removable spike (#1) to the sleeve (#2) with M6 x 20 bolt (#14).




Function 3: Timber Jack

Step 1: Assemble the front T-frame stand (#4) with the sleeve (#2) with a M10 \times 45 bolt (#13) and locknut (#15). Install the wheel (#5) and beam (#11) to the front T-frame stand (#4).


Step 2: Assemble back T-frame stand with the sleeve (#2) with a $M10 \times 45$ bolt (#13) and locknut (#15).

Step 3: Attach the double hook with two teeth (#3) to the sleeve (#2) with a M10 \times 45 bolt (#13) and locknut (#15).

- Be sure to tighten all nuts and bolts before use.
- **Keep the timberjack clean.** A properly maintained timberjack will work more effectively. Keep all of parts dry, clean, and free from oil and grease.
- Cleaning. Use only soap and a damp cloth to clean your timberjack.
