
Tools needed:Allen Key (Part#11) (included)
Phillips Head Screw Driver (Not included)






Step 1
Insert Cam Bolts (Part #4) into pre-drilled holes of parts A, B & H using Phillips Head Screwdriver as shown.
DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.








Step 2 Using Short Flat Head Screws (Part #16), attach the Drawer Side Panels (J2) to one of the Drawer Front Panels (I) as shown. Insert Drawer Bottom Panel (K2) into the grooves of Drawer Sides (J2) as shown.Attach the second Drawer Front Panel(I) to Drawer Sides (J2) using Short Flat Head Screws (Part #16)as shown. Attach Knobs (Part #4) to Drawer Fronts













Step 3
With Base (Q) on its side, attach lower Partition Panel (O2) using Short Wood Dowels (Part #1),Barrel Nuts (Part #7),Flat Washes (Part #15),and Long Hex Socket Head Bolts (Part #8) as shown




Step 4
Attach Lower Side Frames (L)
using Short Wood Dowels
(Part #1), Barrel Nuts (Part
#7), Flat Washers (Part #15),
and Long Hex Socket Head
Bolts (Part #8) as shown.
Note - Be sure that the finished
raised panels are facing out.





Step 5
Attach Upper Side Frame (B) to Top Rails (D) using Short Wood Dowels (Part #1), and Cam Locks (Part #5) as shown.
Attach Upper Partition Panel (E2) to Top Rails (D) using Short Wood Dowels (Part #1), and Long Flat Head Screws (Part #17) as shown.



Step 6
Turn assembled parts B, D & E2
over with Top Rails (D) on a flat
surface. Attach Middle Shelf
Frame (H) using Long Flat Head
Screws (Part #17), and Long
Wood Dowels (Part #2) as
shown.



Step 11

Insert the assembled drawers into the cabinet. Pull one drawer open enough to reach inside and insert the 60mm Wood Dowel (Part #3) into the pre-drilled hole in the Upper Partition Panel (E2). NOTE: Wood Dowel (Part #3) will act as a "stop" to keep the drawers from coming out completely once it is inserted.
