


Cultipacker 3-Point Hitch Adaptor OWNER'S MANUAL

WORK AREA

- Keep work area clean, free of clutter and well lit. Cluttered and dark work areas can cause accidents.
- **Keep children and bystanders** away while operating the cultipacker. Distractions can cause you to lose control, so visitors should remain at a safe distance from the work area.
- Be aware of all power lines, electrical circuits, water pipes and other mechanical hazards in your work area, particularly those hazards below the work surface hidden from the operator's view that may be unintentionally contacted and may cause personal harm or property damage.
- Be alert of your surroundings.

PERSONAL SAFETY

- Stay alert, watch what you are doing and use common sense when using a cultipacker. Do not use while you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication. A moment of inattention while operating a cultipacker may result in serious personal injury.
- **Dress properly.** Do not wear loose clothing, dangling objects, or jewelry. Keep your hair, clothing and gloves away from moving parts.
- Use safety apparel and equipment. This applies to all persons in the work area. Use safety glasses, non-skid safety shoes, hardhat, gloves, dust collection systems, and hearing protection when needed.
- Do not have passengers on the tow vehicle when pulling cultipacker.
- **Do not turn too short when pulling the cultipacker.** Turning too short can result in the cultipacker catching a tire and possibly injuring the operator.

CULTIPACKER USE AND CARE

- **Do not modify the cultipacker in any way.** Unauthorized modification may impair the function and/or safety and could affect the life of the equipment. There are specific applications for which the cultipacker was designed.
- Always check for damaged or worn out parts before using the cultipacker. Broken parts will
 affect operation. Replace or repair damaged or worn parts immediately.
- Store idle cultipacker. When the cultipacker is not in use, store it in a secure place out of the reach of children. Inspect it for good working condition prior to storage and before re-use.
- Transporting cultipacker on hard road type surfaces can result in excessive packer wheel wear
 or possible packer wheel damage.
- Care should be taken when flipping the cultipacker over for either use or transport. Place one foot on the packer wheels and securely hold when flipping. Improper flipping can result in bodily injury and/or property damage.
- There are two grease points on the cultipacker. There is a bearing on each end of the packer wheel shaft. It is recommended that these bearings be greased at least every 4 hours. In dusty conditions more frequent greasing may be necessary.
- For best results it may be necessary to pack the soil before seeding and then pack the soil a second time after seeding. This is especially true with small seeds that require shallow seeding.

OPTIONAL 3-POINT KIT ASSEMBLY


Step #1:

Remove the two M14 nuts (6), washers (5) and bolts (4) from each lower 3-point pin bracket.

Step #2:

Install each lower 3-point pin bracket (1) on the cultipacker frame as shown below. Fasten securely with the M14bolts (4), washers (5) and nuts (6) that were removed in Step 1.

Step #3: Install the connector pins (2) and upper top link pin (3) to your category 1 link arms.
