Jameson introduced the first fiberglass lay-up sticks over 50 years ago to meet the needs of telecommunication linemen, quickly replacing wooden poles as the industry standard.

Today, Jameson's pole line has expanded to include a variety of models, configurations, tools and accessories to meet our customers' specific needs.

- Choose Pole Model Based On Typical Use
- Attach Tool Head (Pruner, Pole Saw, Accessory) to Female Ferrule with Adapter
- For Additional Length, Attach Extension Pole(s) Into Base Pole

All Jameson poles are manufactured with a non-fiberglass surface veil to prevent fiber blooming



Aircraft grade aluminum ferrules with exterior leaf spring locking button provide a secure connection when attaching multiple poles or tool heads

Telescoping Pole with Female Ferrule

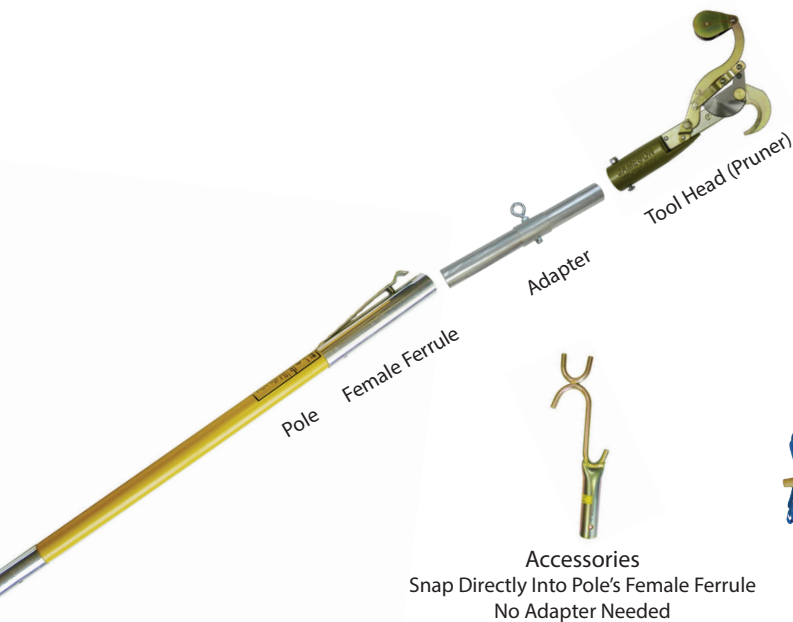


For Highest Performance and Safety, Jameson recommends using a Base Pole when using one pole or starting with Base Pole when working with multiple poles.

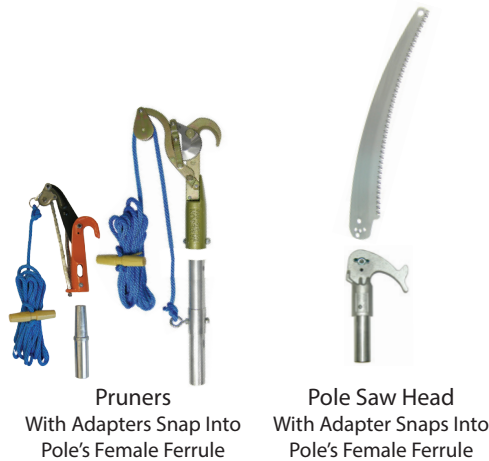

Jameson's Unique Adapter and Pole Ferrule System

Makes it easy to change from a pruner head to pole saw head or lengths of 6' to 12'. The exterior leaf spring locking button on the ferrule offers a strong connection.

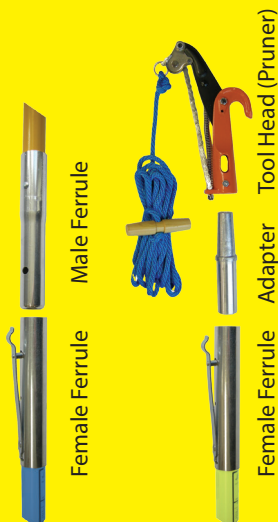


Adapters

- Use different tool heads with the same pole, saving time and money.
- Tool head's adapter locks into pole's ferrule.

Pole Ferrules

- Heavy duty aluminum ferrules
- External leaf spring locking button provides secure connection when attaching multiple poles or tool heads.
- Use any combination of pole models together; all Jameson poles have the same ferrules.



Sawhead Pole

Sawhead is permanently mounted on pole. Saw blade (sold separately) attaches to sawhead.

Option: Buy sawhead with adapter (see Pole Saws) for use with extension pole, allowing the use of other tool heads with the same pole.

Jameson recommends using Sawhead Poles with Base Poles.
