

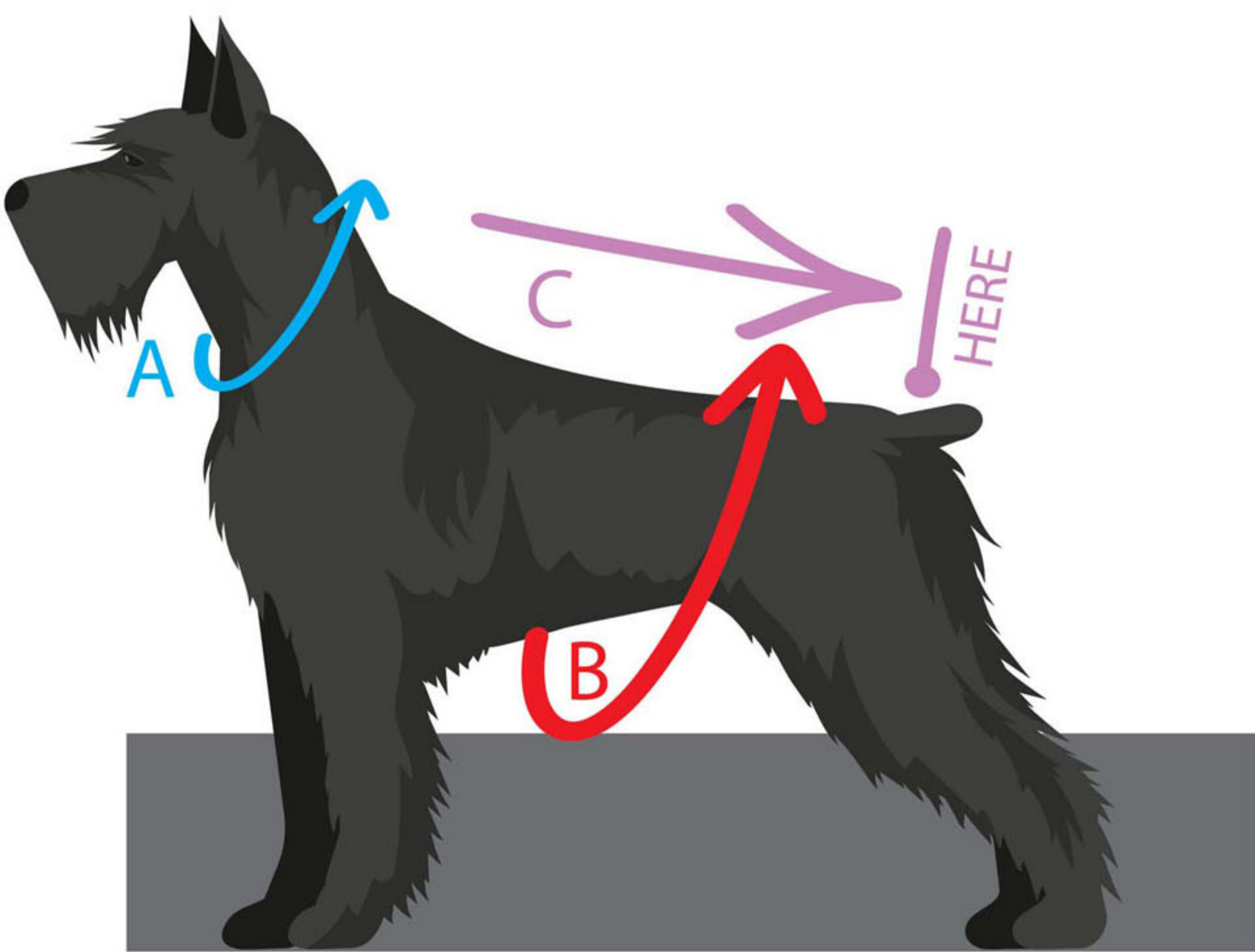
APPAREL SIZING GUIDE



Please Note:

Length, Chest and Neck size ranges typically extend an additional 2 inches

SM	12 in	20 in	16 in	Bichon Frise Terrier Mixes Brussels Griffon Havanese
MD	15 in	23 in	19 in	Beagle Border Collie American Foxhound American Cocker Spaniel
LG	19 in	26 in	21 in	Bulldog Boxer Greyhound Standard Poodle
XL	24 in	30 in	23 in	Mountain Dogs Shepherd Lab Mixes Golden Retriever



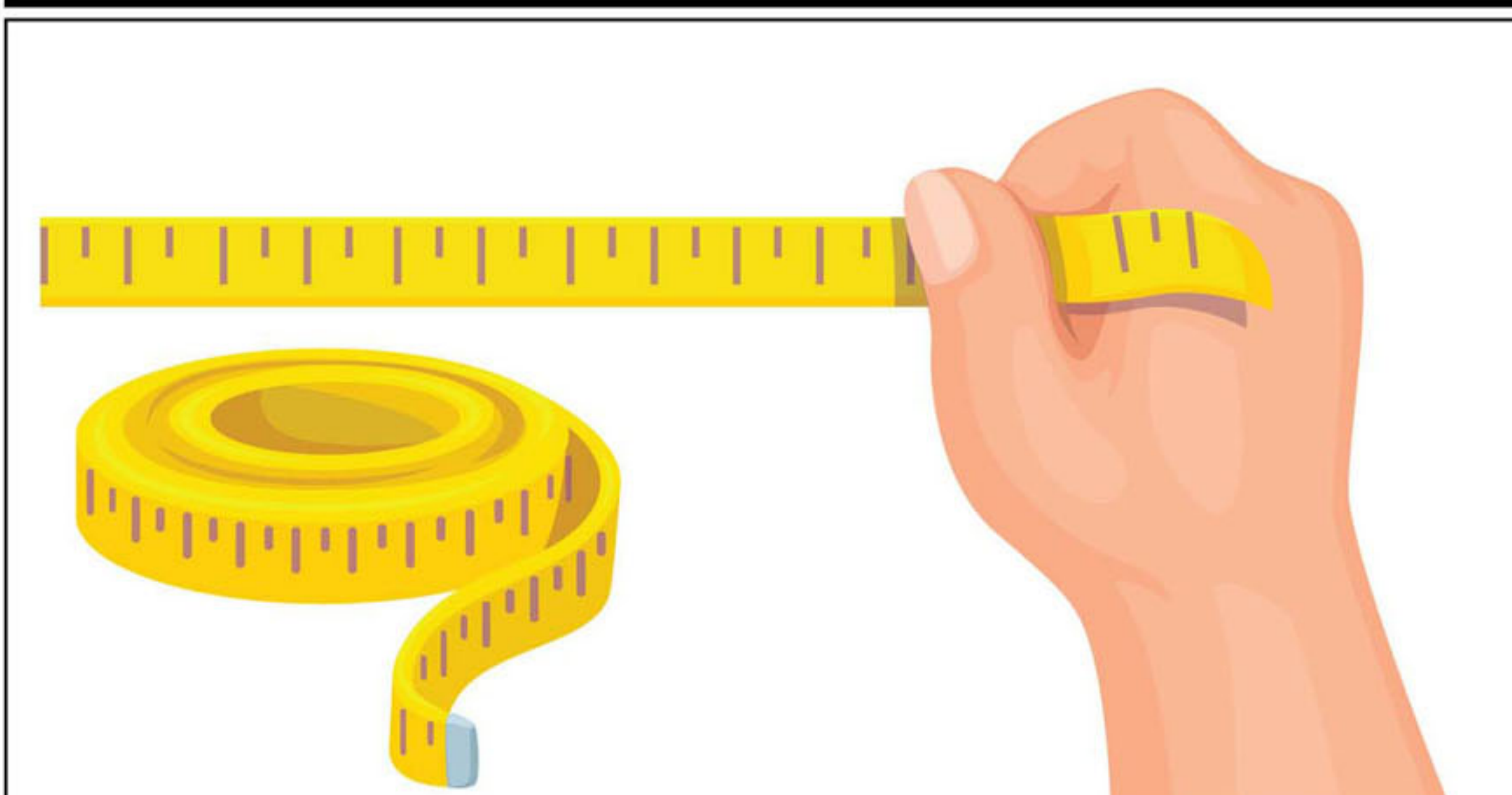
Measurement Instructions

- A.** Measure the circumference or girth around the neck. As per **exhibit A**.
- B.** Measure the circumference or girth around the middle of the Chest area. As per **exhibit B**.
- C.** Measure from the back of the neck area all the way until the tail area in order to determine the length. As per **exhibit C**.

Tips and Suggestions

- Don't rely on weight, all dogs come in various shapes and sizes.
- It's always goods to add 2 fingers when measuring for added snugness to your fit.
