**DESCRIPTION:**

Baby Cakes® is a dwarf and thornless blackberry plant. Its compact habit makes it perfect for patio pots. In summer, large berries present in firework-like displays of fruit. In most regions, this blackberry will produce twice in one season!

**GROWING & CARE NOTES:**

- Non-GMO
- Neutral soil (pH 6.5-7.5), good drainage
- Fertilize with a balanced fertilizer in early spring
- Only prune dead canes with no new growth in the spring. Pruning new canes can affect fruiting
- This plant is self-pollinating
