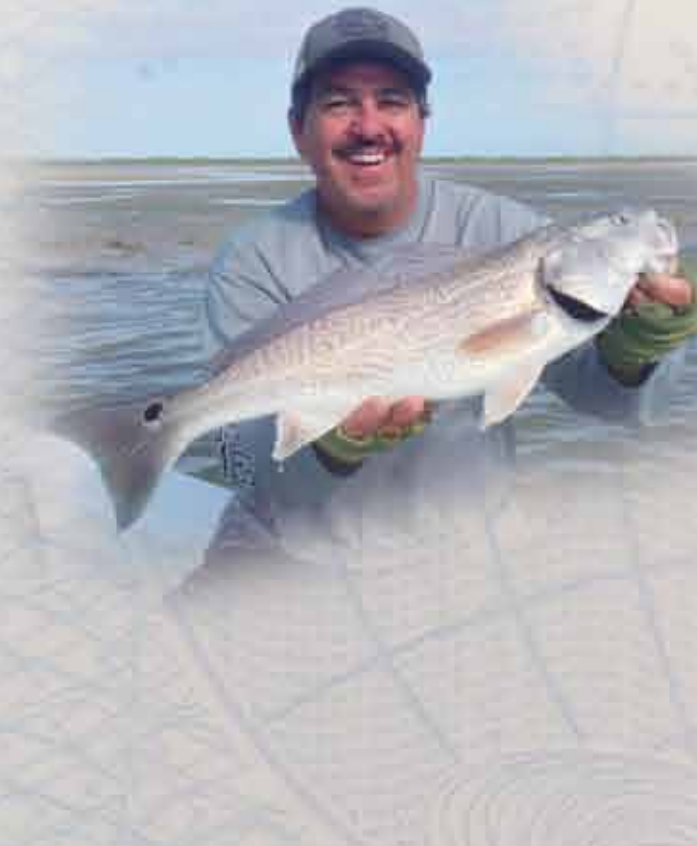

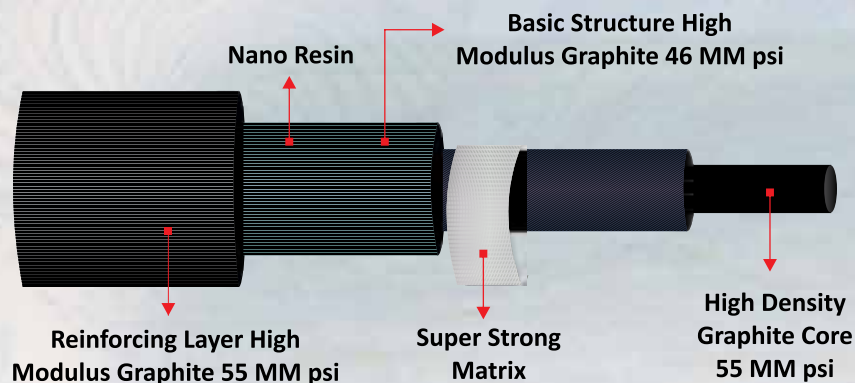

We use extremely efficient materials that add power to the blank with minimal weight, helping us to minimize blank diameter. These materials create the lightest, most sensitive and strongest multiple piece rods on the planet.



PASSPORT® REPLACEMENT PROGRAM (PRP)

Professional fishermen know that even if you have the best fishing rod ever created in your hands, unexpected things can happen. Our rods are unbreakable under correct use, but big fish do go crazy, friends sometimes step on your rod, and we all know that accidents happen. We understand how disappointing having problems on the water can be, and it's why we created the **PRP: Passport® Replacement Program**.

PRP allows for immediate replacement of the broken piece. There's no need for excuses, we don't care how your rod broke, we just want you back on the water with your **Passport®** in hand asap.

HOW TO PROCEED

Simply send the entire rod (not just the broken piece) to our Flying Fisherman® headquarters in Tavernier, Florida. We recommend packing properly and using a carrier that provides tracking information in case of a problem. Please be sure to include your return shipping address, contact info and a check for \$40 to cover the replacement piece, shipping and handling costs.

Your rod with the new replacement piece will be shipped back to you within a few days of receipt. Failure to include proper return shipping information may result in additional fees. This warranty is limited to the standard **Passport®** rods and does not cover custom rods or rods that were modified from their original design.
