

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- Bird guards are bound together with twist-tie and stored in center of TrapStik<sup>®</sup>. Reach into center to pull out bird guards.
- 2. Tear perforated strip on dark green panel and remove cardboard to expose adhesive. (Placing TrapStik® upright on a stable surface allows better leverage.)
- 3. Remove twist-tie surrounding bird guards. Keep it to use for hanging TrapStik®.
- 4. Install bird guards one at a time. With trap upright, insert one end of bird guard into channels on the edge of cap, then install the other end of the bird guard in the same manner. (Grasp inside cap for better leverage). Repeat on all six sides.
- 5. Thread twist-tie through the loops on either end of the cap to hang TrapStik®.

## PLACEMENT:

- Hang TrapStik® from eaves or wherever you see evidence of wasp, mud dauber or carpenter bee activity.
- For best results, hang from man-made structures where these insects nest or bore holes, such as an eave, awning, pergola, garage or shed.
- Avoid hanging where birds or other wildlife activity happens, and where children or pets may come in contact with the adhesive.
- TrapStik® can be placed next to an insect nest to deplete the population.

## **Safety Information:**

Make sure all insects are dead before handling TrapStik®.

If adhesive contacts skin or hair, gently pull TrapStik® away and the adhesive will release. Use petroleum jelly, baby oil or mineral oil to remove any adhesive residue.
