Clear a 4x4 area on the ground and pour out the CRUSHED Jurassic Rock. Throughout a few rain cycles the product will disappear, soaking into the earth creating a mineral lick. Continue to refresh throughout the year as needed. Best used in combination with 12lb Jurassic Rock to kick start your mineral site
