They thrive in the shade, even though they can with stand some sun, are long-lived and low-maintenance. Many Hosta varieties have seasonal color or can change color depending on growing conditions. While there are well over 3,000 cultivars to choose from we offer a range of foliage shapes, colors and sizes. They can take years to fully mature, each year exhibiting a change in color, texture and form.

Very long lived perennial, which grows bigger and more impressive with each season About This Variety: Fire and Ice, a very popular and sought after Hosta variety, sports leaves with pure white centers with darker green margins. Plant as a specimen border plant, as a ground cover en masse, or in pots on the patio and/or balcony. Flowers come mid-summer.

Growing Instructions: While drought tolerant, they do not like being kept dry for long, and prefer rich, well-drained soil with a consistent supply of moisture.

Care Tip: Virtually maintenance free, clip out dead flower stalks after flowering.

Exposure: Partial shade to full shade

Height: Grows 12-18" tall

Spacing: Plant 12-24" apart, 1.5-2" deep
