WARNING: The warnings, cautions, and instructions discussed in this instruction manual cannot cover all possible conditions or situations that could occur. It must be understood by the operator that common sense and caution are factors which cannot be built into this product, but must be supplied by the operator.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

WORK AREA

- Keep work area clean, free of clutter and well lit. Cluttered and dark work areas can cause accidents.
- **Keep children and bystanders** away while operating a Dumpster Dolly Distractions can cause you to lose control, so visitors should remain at a safe distance from the work area.
- **Be alert of your surroundings.** Using a **Dumpster Dolly** in confined work areas may put you dangerously close to cutting tools and rotating parts.

PERSONAL SAFETY

- Stay alert, watch what you are doing and use common sense when using a Dumpster Dolly. Do
 not use a Dumpster Dolly while you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or
 medication. A moment of inattention while operating a Dumpster Dolly may result in serious
 personal injury.
- Dress properly. Do not wear loose clothing, dangling objects, or jewelry. Keep your hair, clothing and gloves away from moving parts. Loose clothes, jewelry or long hair can be caught in moving parts.
- Use safety apparel and equipment. Use safety goggles or safety glasses with side shields
 which comply with current national standards, or when needed, a face shield. Use a dust mask if
 working in dusty work conditions. This applies to all persons in the work area. Also use non-skid
 safety shoes, hardhat, gloves, dust collection systems, and hearing protection when
 appropriate.

Dumpster Dolly USE AND CARE

- Do not modify the Dumpster Dolly in any way. Unauthorized modification may impair the
 function and/or safety and could affect the life of the equipment. There are specific applications
 for which the Dumpster Dolly was designed.
- Always check for damaged or worn out parts before using the Dumpster Dolly. Broken
 parts will affect the Dumpster Dolly operation. Replace or repair damaged or worn parts
 immediately.
- Do not exceed the Dumpster Dolly load capacity.
- **Distribute the load evenly.** Uneven loads may cause the Dumpster Dolly to tip, resulting in personal injury to the operator or others.
- Use the Dumpster Dolly on flat and level surfaces capable of supporting the Dumpster Dolly and its maximum load. Pulling or pushing a load on a slanted or uneven surface can result in loss of control.
- Store idle Dumpster Dolly. When Dumpster Dolly is not in use, store it in a secure place out of the reach of children. Inspect it for good working condition prior to storage and before re-use.

ASSEMBLY

- 1. Slide Fasten Bracket(#A) into Adjust Bracket(#B).
- Tighten Locking Handwheel(#H)
- 3. Attach Adjust Plate(#C) to Fasten Bracket(#A) with Bolts(#D), Washers(#E&#F), and Nuts(#G).


OPERATION

- 1. Slide over 2" Ball
- 2. Adjust to desired height using Handwheel (#H)

MAINTENANCE

Maintain your Dumpster Dolly. It is recommended that the general condition of any Dumpster
Dolly be examined before it is used. Keep your Dumpster Dolly in good repair by adopting a
program of conscientious repair and maintenance. If any abnormal vibrations or noise occurs,
have the problem corrected before further use. Have necessary repairs made by qualified
service personnel.
