INTENDED USE

The Heavy Duty Spare Tire Carrier fits most trailer tongues up to 3" wide and 5" high and will accept from 4 holes to 8 holes. It allows you to easily mount your heavy duty spare tire up and away from the trailer.

GENERAL SAFETY RULES

WARNING: Read and understand all instructions. Failure to follow all instructions listed below may result in serious injury.

CAUTION: Do not allow persons to operate or assemble this spare tire carrier until they have read this manual and have developed a thorough understanding of how the spare tire carrier works.

WARNING: The warnings, cautions, and instructions discussed in this instruction manual cannot cover all possible conditions or situations that could occur. It must be understood by the operator that common sense and caution are factors that cannot be built into this product, but must be supplied by the operator.

WORK AREA

- Keep work area clean, free of clutter, and well-lit. Cluttered and dark work areas can cause accidents.
- **Keep children and bystanders** away while operating a spare tire carrier. Distractions can cause you to lose control, so visitors should remain at a safe distance from the work area.

PERSONAL SAFETY

- Stay alert, watch what you are doing, and use common sense when using a spare tire carrier. Do not use a spare tire carrier while you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or medication. A moment of inattention while operating a spare tire carrier may result in serious personal injury.
- **Dress properly.** Do not wear loose clothing, dangling objects, or jewelry. Keep your hair, clothing, and gloves away from moving parts. Loose clothes, jewelry, or long hair can be caught in moving parts.
- Use safety apparel and equipment. Use safety goggles or safety glasses with side shields that
 comply with current national standards or, when needed, a face shield. Use a dust mask if
 working in dusty work conditions. This applies to all persons in the work area. Also use non-skid,
 safety shoes, hardhats, gloves, dust collection systems, and hearing protection when
 appropriate.
- Read and understand all instructions and safety precautions as outlined in all manufacturers'
 manuals for the trailer you are using. Make sure to mount the Heavy Duty Spare Tire Carrier to
 the manufacturer's recommended mounting positions.

SPARE TIRE CARRIER USE AND CARE

- **Do not modify the Heavy Duty Spare Tire Carrier in any way.** Unauthorized modification may impair the function and/or safety and could affect the life of the equipment. There are specific applications for which the spare tire carrier was designed.
- Always check for damaged or worn-out parts before using the Heavy Duty Spare Tire
 Carrier. Broken parts will affect the Heavy Duty Spare Tire Carrier operation. Replace or repair damaged or worn parts immediately.
- Do not exceed the Heavy Duty Spare Tire Carrier load capacity.
- Mount the Heavy Duty Spare Tire Carrier to balance evenly. Uneven mounting may cause personal injury to the operator
- Store idle spare tire carrier. When spare tire carrier is not in use, store it in a secure place out of the reach of children. Inspect it for good working condition prior to storage and before re-use.

PRE-ASSEMBLY

1. Secure the unloaded trailer with wheel chocks (blocks) on a hard, flat surface capable of supporting the weight of the trailer, the Heavy Duty Spare Tire Carrier, and the required tools.

2. Raise the trailer tongue and secure it with two supports, one on each side of the trailer tongue.

3. Position the Mounting Bracket (#2) in a predetermined position against the side of the trailer tongue.

Note: The Heavy Duty Spare Tire Carrier should be located to the side of the trailer tongue.

Note: The angled Tire Mounting Plate should be positioned upward (above) the Trailer Tongue Plate (plate that attaches to the trailer tongue).



ASSEMBLY

STEP 1:

Attach the two Mounting Brackets (#1) to the Carrier Body (#2). Place the Mounting Brackets (#1) (containing 6 holes) flat against the trailer tongue so that the edges of the Mounting Brackets (#1) curve out away from the trailer tongue. Insert four Hex Bolts (#5) through the Mounting Brackets (#1) as close to the trailer tongue as possible. Slide on four Flat Washers (#8), four Spring Washers (#7), and thread on four Nuts (#6). Use a torque wrench to tighten the Nuts (#6) to 90 ft. lbs.

STEP 2:

Mount the tire on the Carrier Body (#2) with the valve facing outward so that the tire air pressure can be checked at any time.


STEP 3:

Insert three Carriage Bolts (#4) through the back of the Tire Mounting Plate and through the wheel lug holes. Use three Retainer Clips (#9) and three Nuts (#5) to secure the tire in place. Securely tighten and torque all hardware to 90 ft. lbs.

MAINTENANCE

Maintain your Heavy Duty Spare Tire Carrier. It is recommended that the general condition of
any Heavy Duty Spare Tire Carrier be examined before it is used. Keep your Heavy Duty Spare
Tire Carrier in good repair by adopting a program of conscientious repair and maintenance. If
any abnormal vibrations or noise occurs, have the problem corrected before further use. Have
necessary repairs made by qualified service personnel.
