DIRECTIONS FOR USE



AREA	APPLICATION RATE
 TOMATOES	Add 2-3 Tbsp. per hole before planting. Each month, sprinkle 1 Tbsp. per foot height to the plant at the base of the stem and scratch into the soil.
 FRUITS & VEGETABLES	Dissolve 1 Tbsp. per gallon and use as a foliar spray monthly, or sprinkle 1 Tsp. per foot height of the plant at the base of each plant every 2 weeks during the growing season.
 ROSES & OTHER FLOWERS	Use ½ cup in the soil at the base of the plant. Afterwards, use a foliar spray, mixing 1 Tbsp. per gallon, or use 1 Tsp. per foot height of each plant every 2 weeks during the growing season.
 POTTED PALMS	Apply ½ cup per gallon of water, 3 times a year. To prevent or reduce yellowing, spray with a mixture of 1 Tbsp. per gallon.
 IN-GROUND PALMS	For mature palm trees in the ground, use 1 to 5 LB depending on the age and size of the tree. Apply 4 times per year around the tree base.
 EVERGREENS, AZALEAS, & RHODODENDRONS	Use ½ Tbsp. around the base of the plants and shrubs every 2 to 4 weeks, or mix ½ cup per gallon of water. Then water with mixture over leaves and root zone every 3 to 4 weeks.
 TREES	Sprinkle dry, or water with 1 Tbsp. per gallon in a circle of the tree drip-line 3 times per year.
 LAWNS	Apply 6 LB for every 2,500 SQ. FT. Use a spreader, or dilute using a garden hose with a sprayer attachment. Apply only to actively growing turf.
 NUTRIENT RICH BED	Work in 2 cups per 100 SQ. FT. of planting area.
