## **SIZING INSTRUCTIONS**

Measure according to our drawings and instructions below for most accurate results. Boots do run big so if in doubt go down a size.

Note: Back paws may be smaller than front paws.

## **MEASURING PAW SIZE**

- 1. Have your dog stand on a firm surface
- 2. Place a blank piece of paper under a front paw and apply gently pressure to measured paw
- Mark the paper at the top, including toenails. Add marks at the heel and both sides of the paw
- 4. Use a ruler to measure the width of the paw between the 2 outer pads.
- Boot length refers to the length from the toes to wear the top of the boot will rest. Most boots lay just below the dew claw.
- Measure the circumference This is the thickness of the paw. Since this is a wrap-around boot the measurement provides an indication on the average thickness of a paw that the boot will fit.
- 7. Use the chart to choose the dog shoe size that is the closest fit for the entire paw including toenails and fur. If it's borderline, go for the larger size.
