


• Please select a flat and level location to position and assemble the chicken coop and run.


Step 1

• Connect the short side of side panel (1) with standard panel (2) using clamps (7). Secure with bolts (10) and nuts (12).

**PLEASE NOTE: Arrange panels as shown below.









Step 2


• Connect the tall sides of panels (1) using clamps (7). Secure with bolts (10) and nuts (12) as shown below.








Repeat steps 1 and 2 to assemble the remaining panels.
 **PLEASE NOTE: before finishing panel assembly, choose desired position of coop attachment frame (4) & door panel (3).
 Please note the chicken coop mounting panel must be positioned with the coop sliding door handle hole to the outside corner.




Step 4


• Connect two roof panels (5) using connectors (6) as shown below. This will be half of the run roof. Note: These two panels will complete one half of the roof assembly.




• Lift the completed roof panel assembly to the top of the side panels as shown below. Allow roof to rest on the four pre-welded clamps, then use clamps (8) to tighten the four pre-welded clamps and secure with bolts (10) and nuts (12).



• Repeat steps 4 - 5 to complete the second half of the roof assembly.



• Complete the roof assembly by installing clamps (9) and secure with bolts (11) and nuts (12).



• The chicken run is now complete. Next, assemble the chicken coop near the coop attachment frame.



Step 1

• All the parts needed for step 1 are listed below.


- Connect right (2) & left (3) panels for storage area to front door (1) and secure the four corners with bolts (43) & nuts (45). DO NOT tighten at this step.
- Lay out parts (4) and (5) as shown below, then connect to door panel and side panels with bolts (43).
 Now you can tighten the bolts.

• Place the floor panel (6) on the support rods (5). Slide the mid-panel (7) into the grooves of (2) & (3) and cover with connecting rod (4). Secure the connecting rod (4) to (2) & (3) with bolts (43).





Place connecting rod (10) between panels (8) and (9) as shown below and secure with bolts (43).

- Secure the other side with connecting rod (11) and bolts (43).
- Place support rod (12) between rods (10) & (11) and secure using bolts (43).
- Place support rod (5) between rods (1) & (10) and secure using bolts (43).





• Follow below drawing, put the floor panel (14) on top of the two support rod (5), and then insert the 3 nesting box dividers (13) through the grooves on the floor (14).




• Insert the door panel of the nesting box (15) on top of storage area front door (1). Put the two support frames (16, 17) on two corners of the door panel (15).

• Slide the right panel (18) into the right side of nesting area and the left panel (19) into the left side as shown below.



• Cover the right top edge by the right slant rod (20), and the left top edge by the left slant rod (21) ,and fix by 6pcs self -tapping screws (46).





- Put the two trays (23) on top of the frame.





• Slide window panel (24) into position and cover with connecting rod (25). Then secure the rod to both ends using bolts (43).





- Put the connectors for ramp (40) onto the (11) as shown below and make the distance between the two connectors as 8.27" from the center of the pre-drilled holes in ramp connectors.
- Place steel trays (26R,26L) into position. Please note that two of the four edges are wider and when assembling, please put the wider edges facing inward. Attach the trays to the frame on the wider side with screws (46).





• Slide back door panel (27) into connecting rod (11). Place connecting rod (28) onto panel (27) and fasten to side panels using bolts (43). Then, slide upper back panel (29) into the upper groove of connecting rod (28). Place rod (25) onto back panels (29) and fasten to both sides using bolts (43).







- Fix roof connecting frame (30) on back edge (no asphalt edge) of the nesting box roof (31), using tapping screws (47) 3pcs. Drawing A.
- Following drawing B, assemble L-G-plate I (32) and R-G-plate I (33) on two sides of (31) by tapping screws (47).
- Same way, assemble (34, 36, 37) to the edge of the main roof (35). Drawing C & D.



• Place both roof panels into position. Then, secure the right and left side of both roofs to the frame with screws(46) &(47).





- Now, the chicken coop is ready to be attached to the run.




• Assemble the chicken coop to the run panel using clamps (41) and screws (46) on the four positions as shown below.

• Assemble the ramp (39) to the chicken coop. Fix the connectors (40) to ramp with bolts (44) & Nuts (45) & washer (49) as shown below.


