Growing Instructions: Plant about 16 bulbs per square foot. They look best grouped. Extend the blooming season in a cut garden by planting a few bi-weekly as they bloom about 10-12 weeks after planting. They can also be grown in pots indoors.

Care Tip: In USDA zones cooler than 9, the corms will not survive the winter and thus they should be dug up should you want to over winter them.

Exposure: full sun to partial shade *Height:* grows 12-24" tall *Spacing:* plant 2" apart, 2" deep *USDA Zones:* hardy in USDA zones 9-10
