Growing Instructions: While drought tolerant, they do not like being kept dry for long, and prefer rich, welldrained soil with a consistent supply of moisture.

Care Tip: Virtually maintenance free, clip out dead flower stalks after flowering.

Exposure: partial shade to full shade *Height*: grows 24" tall *Spacing*: plant 48-60" apart, 1.5-2" deep *USDA Zones*: hardy in USDA zones 3-9
