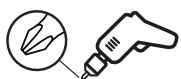

### Kit Contents

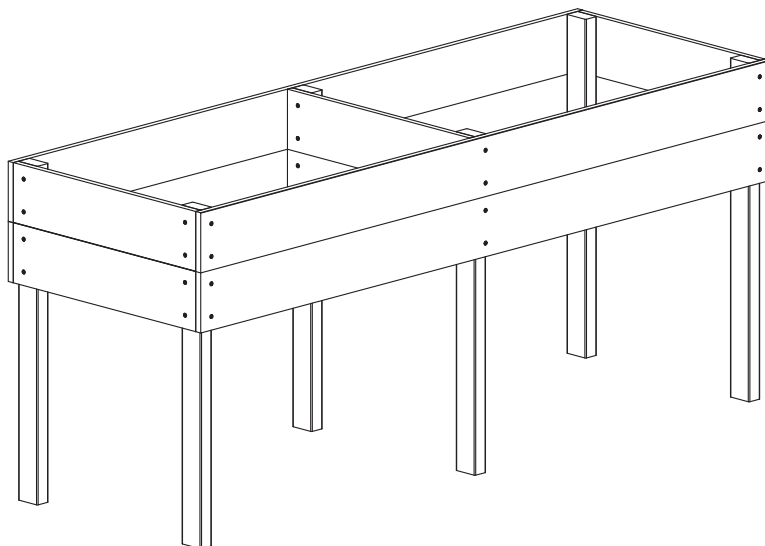
- A** 6 – Legs
- B** 3 – Short boards (no cleat)
- C** 2 – Long boards (no cleat)
- D** 2 – Long boards with cleat
- E** 2 – Short end boards with cleat
- F** 1 – Short middle board with two cleats
- G** 3 – Notched floor boards
- H** 24 – Straight floor boards
- I** 48 – #6 X 1.625" Bugle head screws

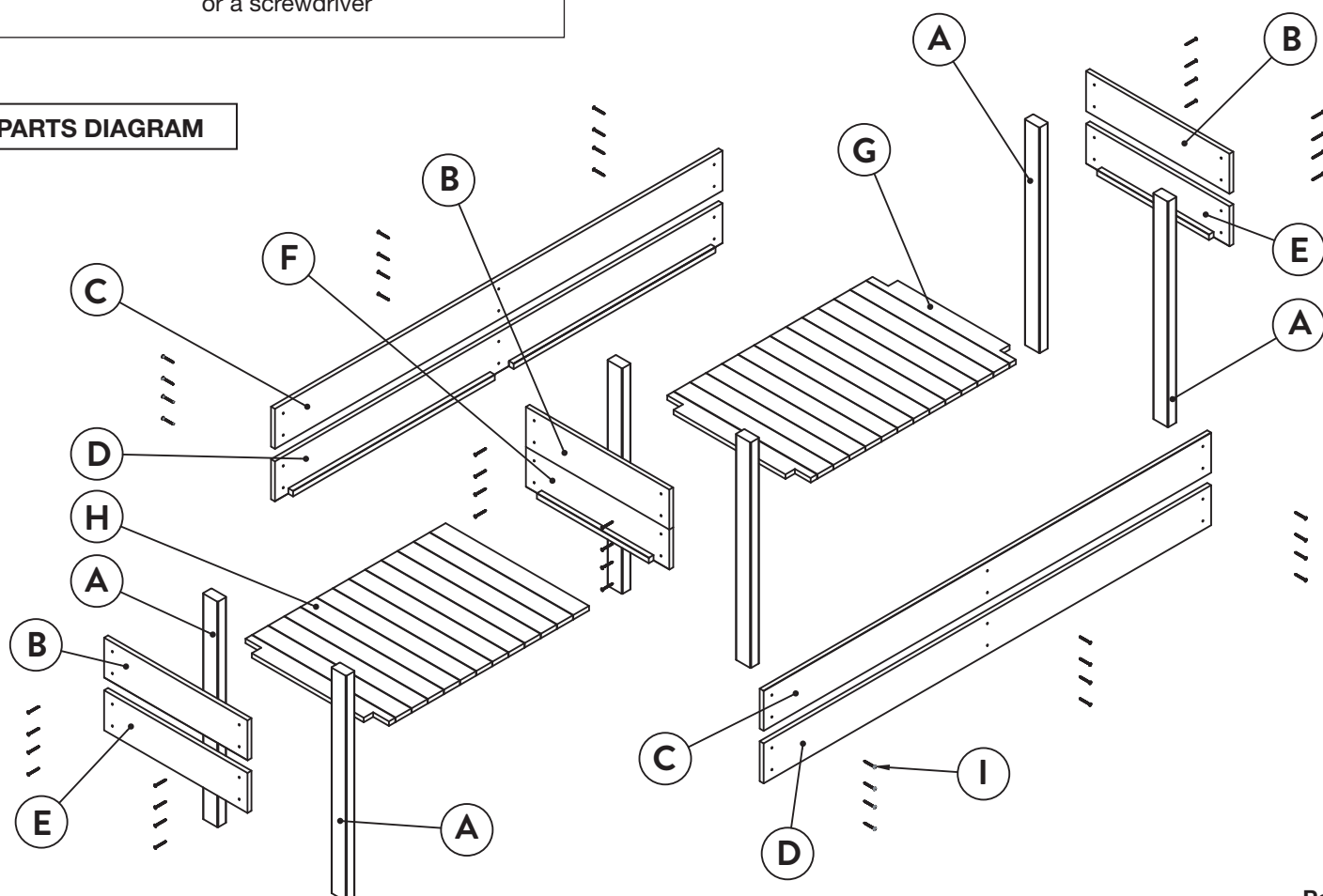

or a screwdriver



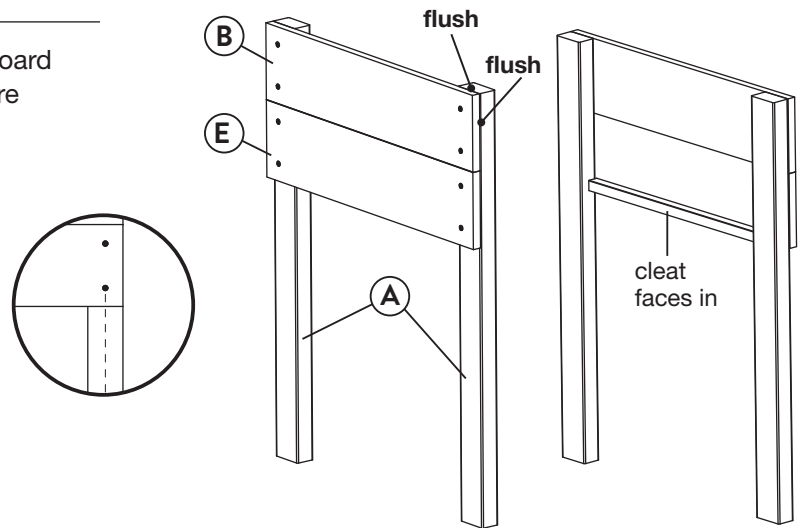
### PARTS DIAGRAM



# 6' RUSTIC ELEVATED GARDEN PLANTER – ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

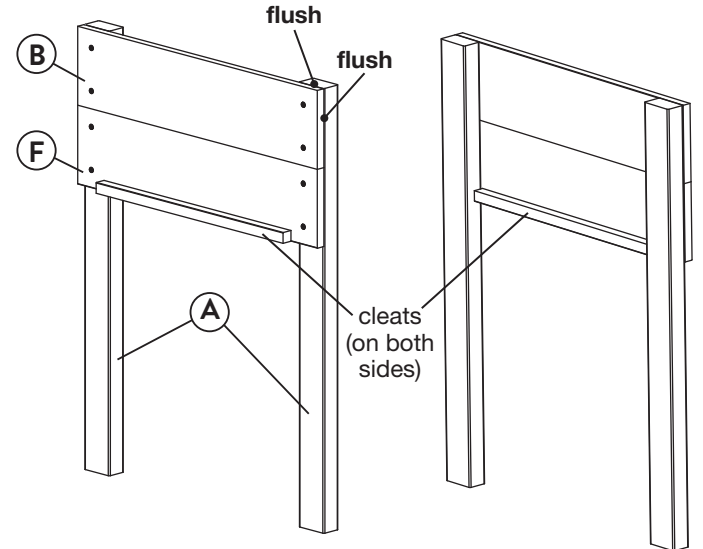
## STEP 1 ASSEMBLE THE TWO ENDS

- Place one short board (B) and one short end board with cleat (E) onto the legs (A) as shown. Secure with screws (I) through the predrilled holes.
- Repeat with second side.



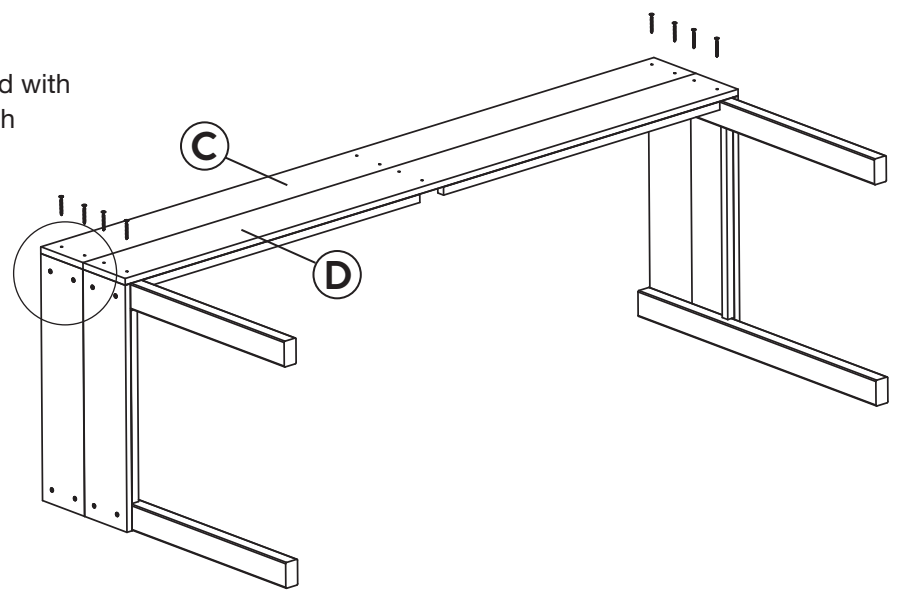
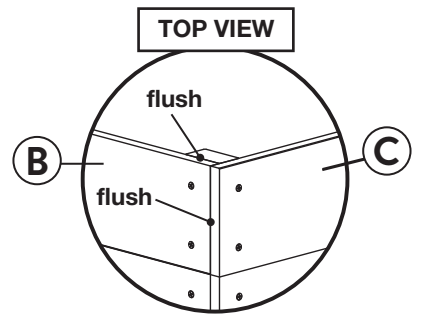
## STEP 2 ASSEMBLE THE MIDDLE

- Place one short board (B) and the short board with two cleats (F) onto the legs (A) as shown. Secure with screws (I) through the predrilled holes.



## STEP 3A ASSEMBLE THE SIDES

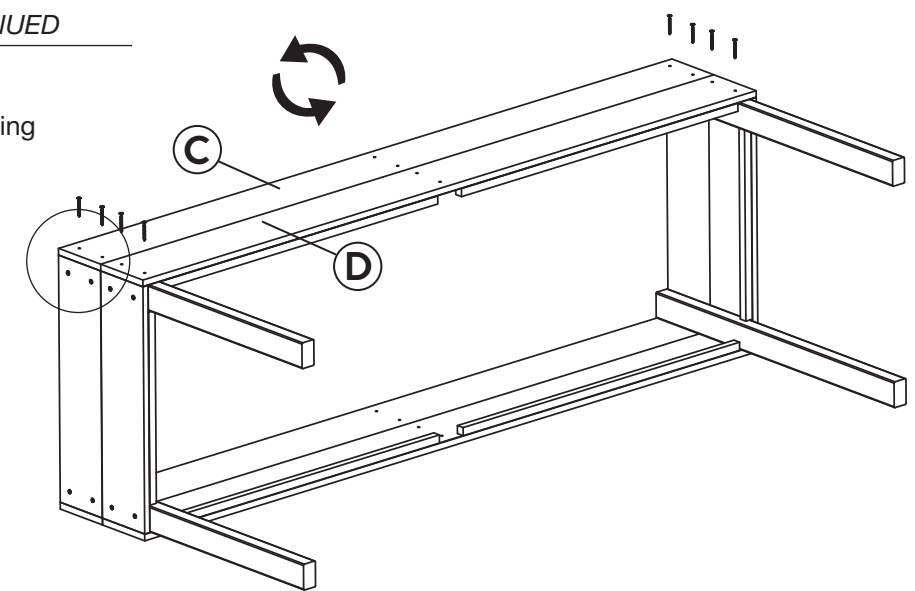
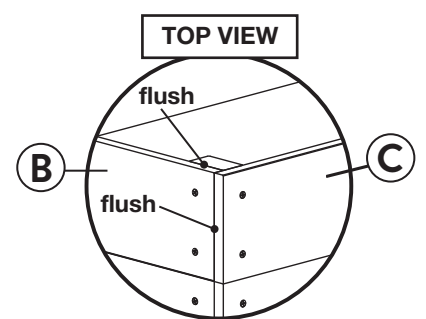
- Turn the two ends on their sides as shown, cleat facing in.
- Place one long board (C) and one long board with cleat (D) onto the legs as shown. Secure with screws (I) through the predrilled holes.



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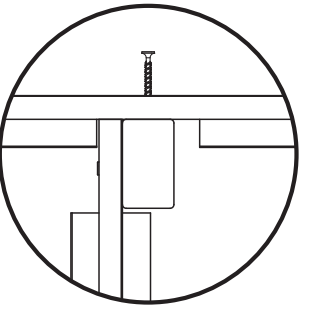
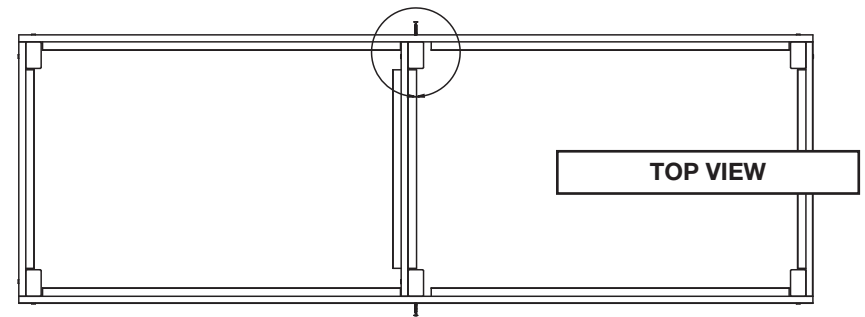
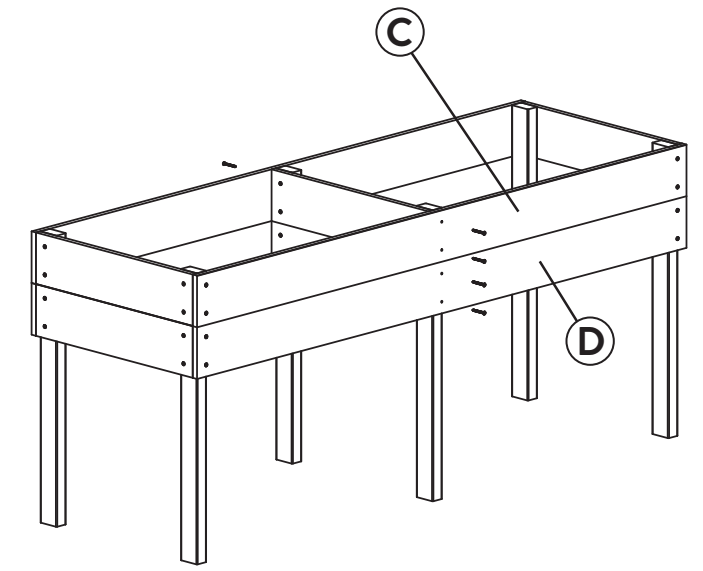
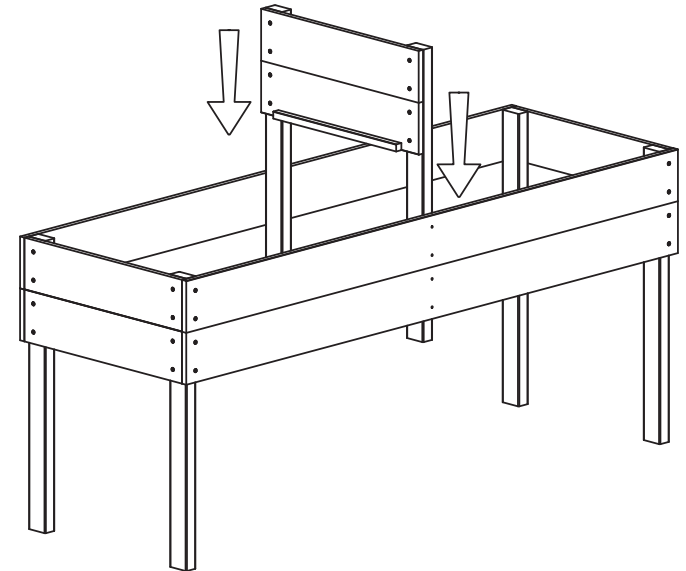
## STEP 3B ASSEMBLE THE SIDES CONTINUED

- Carefully flip the table over.
- Assemble the second side as shown, following instructions in Step 3A.



## STEP 4 ATTACH THE MIDDLE TO THE SIDES

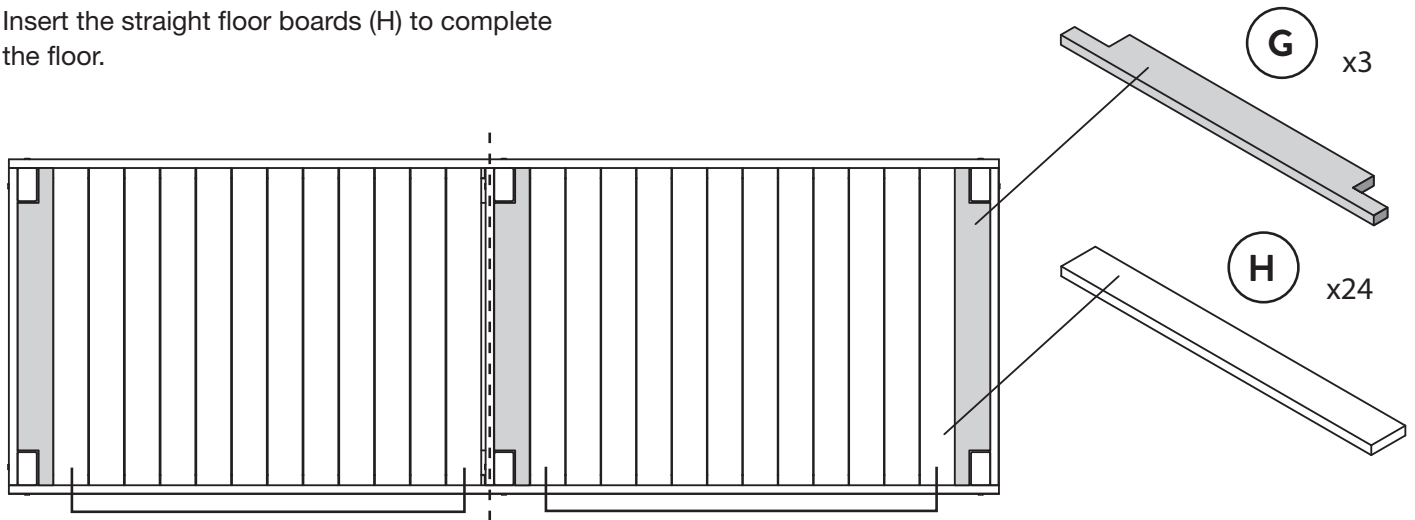
- Slide the middle into the frame and attach to the sides as shown. Be sure the screws are centered into the middle of the legs.



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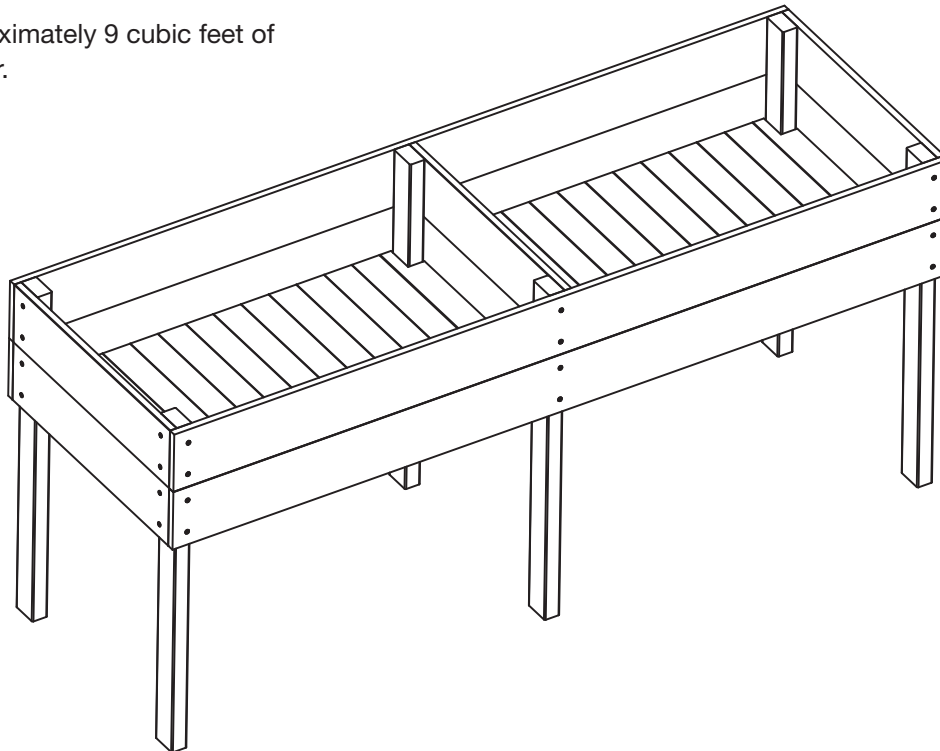
## STEP 5 ASSEMBLE THE FLOOR

- Drop in the floor boards with notches (G) into the spaces that butt up against the legs as shown.
- Insert the straight floor boards (H) to complete the floor.



## STEP 6 INSERT THE PROVIDED LINERS

- You will need approximately 9 cubic feet of soil to fill the planter.



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
