

STEEL FENCE: TEN YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

What is Covered

Origin Point Brands, LLC warrants that the coating on its Steel Fence product will protect the fence from rust through for a period of ten (10) years from the date of purchase. Origin Point Brands also warrants that the fence will be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of ten (10) years. This warranty is extended only to an original purchaser who installed the product at a residence (not commercial premises) in the 50 United States. It is not transferable.

If a defect exists, Origin Point Brands will, at its option, either repair or replace the product or the defective component. This warranty does <u>not</u> cover the costs of labor to remove a defective product or component or install any replacement product or component.

This warranty shall <u>not</u> apply to defects or damages caused by mishandling, improper installation or installation not in accordance with the instructions provided with the product, alteration, removal or reinstallation, improper or unreasonable use, maintenance or storage, use of incompatible accessories, accident, impact by foreign objects, fire, acts of God or normal wear and tear.

No person is authorized to extend or otherwise modify this Warranty.
