
Van Zyverden's HOSTA PATRIOT





Hostas are not grown for their flowers but for their lush foliage. Available in a spectrum of blues, golds, greens, yellows and whites as well as variegated, speckled and striped. Hostas thrive in the shade, even though they can withstand some sun. Long-lived and low maintenance.

About This Variety: Patriot is one of the most popular hosta cultivars. It produces large, variegated, oval-shaped leaves with white margins. Can spread up to 30" wide.

Growing Instructions: While drought tolerant, they do not like being kept dry for long. Prefer rich, well-drained soil with a consistent supply of moisture.

Care Tip: Basically maintenance free. Clip out dead flower stalks after flowering.


Blooms: July to August

Exposure: Partial to full shade

Height: Grows 12-20" tall

Spacing: Plant 18-36" apart, 1.5-2" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 3-8
