About This Variety: This collection consists of: 5 Kniphofia uvaria Grandiflora, 25 Crocosmia Lucifer and 5 Rudbeckia fulgida Goldstrum roots and bulbs. Planting stock is individually packed, bagged and labeled.

Growing Instructions: To ensure optimal results, allow adequate space and sunlight, plant at the appropriate depth, and feed with a well balanced fertilizer. Best planted in early spring, after last frost, so they can establish themselves before hot weather arrives. Some gardeners treat perennials as annuals. For an informal look, plant in groups in natural swathes.

Care Tip: Newly planted roots need extra moisture during their first year in the garden to ensure that they form a solid root system.

Blooms: June to July

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 18-48" tall

Spacing: Plant 6-24" apart, 1-3" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 6-9
