Trouble Shooting Guide CreoleFeast
Q: My cookers' flame appears very weak.
A: If the hose assembly has Type1 Connection (black/green knob), it is equipped with a flow limiting device...

Operating / Cooking Instructions CreoleFeast
Operating Instructions
1. Check that your 20 lb. LP gas cylinder is not over filled and has the proper CGC type 1 connection.
2. Check that your hose assembly is set to restrict gas flow. With the adjustable regulator provided, turn the regulator control counterclockwise until loose.

Operating / Cooking Instructions CreoleFeast
Lighting Instructions
1. Read instruction before lighting.
2. Turn regulator control valve to the OFF position.
3. Fully open the LP tank valve.
4. DO NOT stand with your head or arms over the enclosure. Slowly turn on the regulator valve one turn clockwise.

Preparation CreoleFeast
Before beginning assembly, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with packaged contents list and diagram above. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble the product. Contact customer service for replacement parts or telephone or email.

Assembly Instructions CreoleFeast
Step 1
Place the stove stand (1) upside down on a flat surface as shown.
Install the burner frame (11) assembly using 4 pcs M6x12 bolts (A), M6 nuts (B) and washers (C) with the Phillips screwdriver, as illustrated.

LP tank CreoleFeast
Leak Testing Valves, Hoses and Regulator
1. Turn control knob to OFF.
2. Be sure the regulator is tightly connected to the LP tank.
3. Completely open the LP tank valve by turning the hand wheel counterclockwise. If you hear a hissing sound, turn the gas off immediately. This means there is a major leak at the connection. Correct before proceeding.

LP tank CreoleFeast
CONNECTING REGULATOR TO LP TANK:
• Place the LP tank on a secure level, and stable surface.
• Turn control knob to the "OFF" position.
• Turn LP tank OFF by turning the hand wheel clockwise to a full stop.

Assembly Instructions CreoleFeast
Step 4
Insert the regulator hose (12) into the burner venturi tube. Securely tighten by hand. Then fully tighten with adjustable wrench.

Assembly Instructions CreoleFeast
Fully Assembled
This diagram shows the final assembled unit, including the stove stand, fryer, and gas cylinder connected.

LP tank CreoleFeast
DANGER
