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


## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Follow the instruction for the material of your special product to make sure that it stays in the best shape for as long as possible. The information below is only intended as a general guideline. For more information, please contact us.

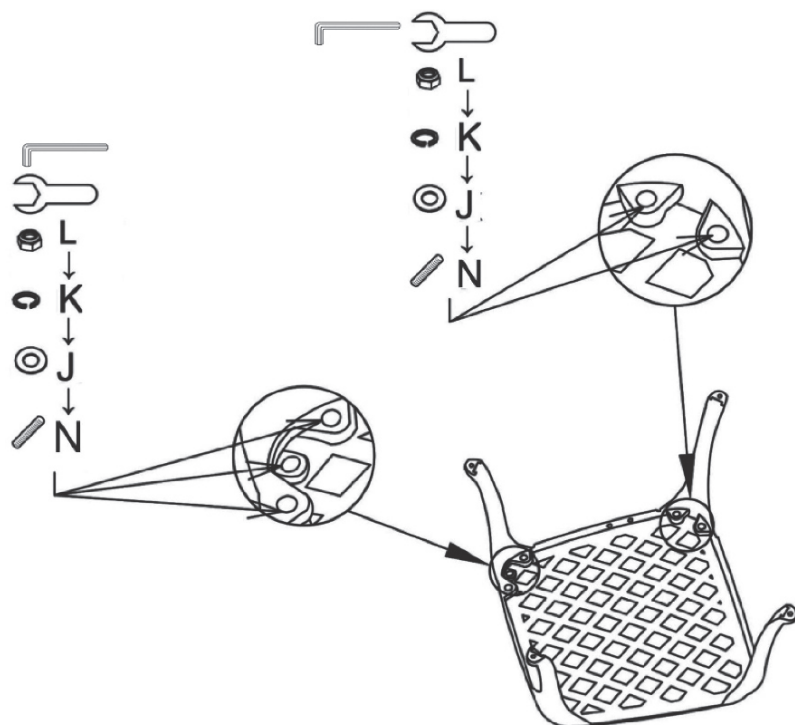
- Only need to rinse it thoroughly with clean water to wash away dirt and grime. Never use abrasive cleansers on the furniture, since it can attack the surfaces and leave behind scratch marks.
- For the stubborn grime and stains, just use a soft sponge and mild soapy water and then dry it with a cloth or paper towel.
- Check the stability of the screws, nuts and nut caps prior to each use. Tighten up them after one to two month's use whenever required.
- Avoid improper use, and be careful not to scratch or damage the surface with sharp objects.
- When you move your furniture, make sure you lift it rather than pulling or pushing it to avoid damaging the foot, legs and mounting.

# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

## ! CAVEAT

Note: Please do not tighten any bolt until all bolts have been put into right place.  
If you tighten one bolt, it maybe cause other bolts out of position.



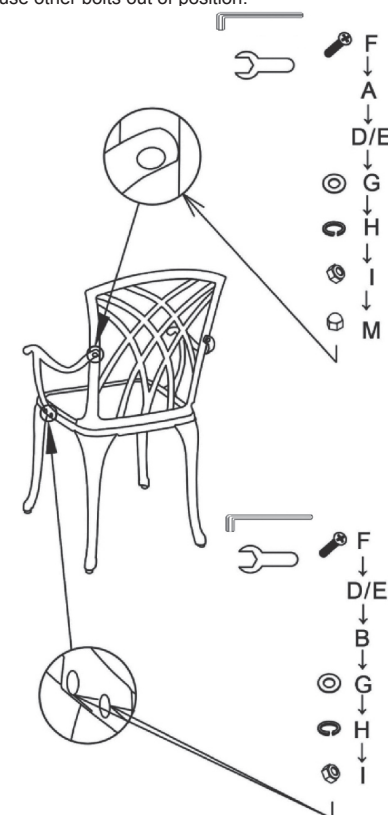
## STEP 1

Attach the front and back legs (C) to the chair seat (B) using studs (N), washers and nuts (J, K, L). Do not tighten the nuts.  
Attach the backrest (A) to the chair seat (B) using studs (N), washers and nuts (J, K, L). Do not over tighten.

# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

## ! CAVEAT

Note: Please do not tighten any bolt until all bolts have been put into right place.  
If you tighten one bolt, it maybe cause other bolts out of position.



## STEP 2

Attach the right and left arm (D, E) to the backrest (A) using the bolts (F) and washers and nuts (G, H, I). Do not over tighten.  
Attach the right and left arm (D, E) to the chair seat (B) using the bolts (F) and washers and nuts (G, H, I). Do not over tighten.  
Upon completion full assembly and bolted up - all screws can be tightened down.  
Add the protect hats (M).
