TULIP ORANGE JUICE



Tulips are a must for every garden because they are sturdy, upright and bright and may bloom for several springs in a row. Generally upward-facing blooms appear on short to tall stems, depending on the variety. Foliage color ranges from green to gray-green to variegated lance-shaped leaves. There are over 15 divisions by which tulips are grouped, each having their own distinct qualities. Plant several different varieties of tulips throughout the garden to extend the blooming time.

About This Variety: Triumph Tulip Orange Juice is recognized and grown for its bright orange blossoms.

Growing Instructions: To ensure optimal results, allow adequate space and sunlight, plant at the appropriate depth, and feed with a well balanced fertilizer. Remove the flowers after they bloom, but allow the leaves to yellow before removing. They are best planted in late fall. Some gardeners treat tulips as annuals. For an informal look, plant in groups in natural swathes or bouquets.

Care Tip: In USDA zones 8-10, refrigerate the bulbs for no less than eight weeks. In the garden, plant them before frost, but not as early as in the northern part of the country. Planting them in a lightly shaded area will keep them cool and prolong blooming.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 14-24" tall

Spacing: Plant 4-8" apart, 4-8" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 3-8
