- happens, the stimulation level is too high and you need to go back to the previous level and repeat the process. The static shock intensity may be reduced when the dog or collar is/are wet,
- make sure the dog and collar is/are dry during use. DO NOT charge the device near any flammable substances.
- For dog use only. Not for use on Humans.
- This is not a toy, and should only be operated by responsible adult.



- Do NOT leave the collar on the dog for more than 12 hours per day.
- When possible re-position the collar on the dog's neck every 1 to 2 hours. Check the fit to prevent excessive pressure; follow the instructions in this manual.
- Never connect a lead to the collar; it will cause excessive pressure on the contacts.

- Examine the contact area daily for signs of a rash or a sore. If a rash or sore is found, discontinue use of the collar until the skin has

- healed. If the condition persists beyond 48 hours, see your veterinarian. Receiver collar meets IP67 water proof rating, it can be submerged into water
- up to 1 meter for up to 30 minutes. If submerged and wet, please do not use. This product comes with conductive silicone covers, please ensure they are worn on the contact points before putting the receiver on your dog and check for the presence of the silicone cover every hour.

These steps will help keep your dog safe and comfortable. Some dogs are comfortable while they wear stainless steel contacts. Some doas are sensitive to contact pressure. Silicone Cans You may find some dogs are sensitive to the collar. If so, you may relax some of these precautions. It is important to continue daily checks of the contact area. If redness or sores are found, discontinue use until the skin has fully healed.





1. Charging the Device

The Remote Training Collar use Lithium-Polymer batteries, DO NOT charge the device near Press the Warning Tone button and Receiver will deliver a warning tone. It will cut off any flammable substances. Fully charge the Remote Transmitter and Receiver Collar Charge the Remote Training Collar if:

The indicator on the Receiver Collar is blinking rapidly or will not come on.

SETTING UP

There is only 1 battery level bar left on the Remote Transmitter LCD display, or indicator on Remote Transmitter will not come on.

Charging Steps: 1. Lift the rubber cover on the Receiver Collar charging jack.

2. Connect the USB cable connectors to the charging jack on Receiver Collar

and Remote Transmitter. 3. Connect the USB cable port the charger/power bank/laptop with 5V output.

The charging time takes 2~3 hours, indicator on both Remote Transmitter and Receiver Collar will blink slowly when charging.

Remote Transmitter: Fully charged, the Green LED indicator will become solid. Receiver Collar: Fully charged, the Green LED indicator will be come solid.

In case you have to use chargers for charging, please use

those with 5V output voltage. Improper chargers will cause charing damage to the device. If it's on charge with improper chargers, receiver Collar will deliver Warning Tone continuously and red indicator will

blink fast on Remote Transmitter.

1. Improper chargers mean those with output voltage

Press the Vibration button and Receiver will deliver a vibration. It will cut off automatically if you press and hold the Vibration button for 10 seconds. There are 2. Output Voltage usually can be seen on surface of total 16 levels of Vibration for training which you can adjust by the Level Button.

2. Turn On/Off the Product

To turn the Remote Transmitter on

1. Press and Hold to for 2 seconds to power on

the Remote Transmitter. The backlight will be on. 2.Backlight will be off at 15 seconds if there is no operation on the Remote Transmitter Buttons. 3.LCD display will be turned off at 2 minutes if there is no operation.


To turn the Remote Transmitter off Press and Hold 🗱 for 2 seconds to power off the Remote Transmitter.

To turn the Receiver Collar on Press and Hold the Power Button for 2 seconds, the Receiver Collar will vibrate and LED Indicator

will starts blinking in green. To turn the Receiver Collar off Press and Hold the Power Button for 3 seconds,

the Receiver Collar will emit a Warning Tone and green LED indicator turns off.






To extend the life of the batteries, turn off the Remote Transmitter and Receiver





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

How to Test the Functions

- Press the 👊 to test the Warning Tone function. The Receiver Collar will deliver Warning Tone indicating that the Warning Tone

Vibration Test

The Receiver Collar will vibrate indicating that the Vibration function works.

Static Shock Test

Secure the test Bulb Kit on the Receiver Collars' metal prongs / silicone caps. Press the 🌃 to test the Static Shock function.



Positioning Light Test


- Press - Button to test the Positioning Light. - Positioning Light will be on when you press - indicating this function works.

For your dog's comfort and safety, please ensure the conductive silicone caps are worn on the metal prongs before putting the Receiver Collar on your dog. The conductive silicone caps can deliver the static shock.




If you feel the Receiver Collar is not responding to the Remote Transmitter. follow these steps to pair them up.


Press and hold the power button on the Receiver Collar for 2 seconds to turn on the Receiver Collar.




ress the power button on Receiver Collar 3 times to enter the pairing mode. You will hear a Warning Tone and the indicator become solid. You will now have 10 seconds to finish the pairing.



Press the ℚ) or 乿 or ∠ or · i on the Remote Transmitter, and Receiver Collar will respond correspondingly indicating that pairing process is completed.







You can choose press 🏶 to choose channel 1 or channel 2 to pair the Remote Transmitter and Receiver Collar. The system can pair 2 Receiver Collars simultaneously. If you can not pair the device successfully, it maybe caused by the signal interference. Please try in a new place or contact with our service center.

The Remote Transmitter and Receiver Collar will only work on the channel you have paired. For example, if you have paired Remote Transmitter to Receiver Collar on Channel 1, Remote Transmitter can control Receiver Collar only on Channel 1, and it will not work on Channel 2. If you buy a new extra Receiver Collar, follow above steps to pair the new Receiver Collar to Remote

training. The Metal Prongs with Conductive Silicone Caps must have direct contact with your doa's skin on the underside of his neck. To assure a proper fit. please follow these steps:

- 3. Place the Receiver Collar on your dog's neck close to the ears. Center the Contact

It is sometimes necessary to trim the hair around the Contact Points to make sure that contact is consistent.

Do not shave the dog's neck as this may increase the risk of skin irritation.

- 4. The Receiver Collar should fit snugly, yet loose enough to allow one finger to fit between the strap and your dog's neck (3C).
- Check the fit again as your dog becomes more comfortable with the Receiver Collar.






The proper fit and placement of your Receiver Collar is important for effective

- 1. Make sure that the Receiver Collar is turned off.
- Have your dog standing comfortably (3A).
- Points underneath your dog's neck, touching the skin.

5. Allow your dog to wear the collar for several minutes then recheck the fit.






6. How to attach the strap to the Receiver Collar? Follow the A-B-C-D steps instructed to the thread the strap.

Collar has 8 types Warning Tone, 16 levels for Vibration and 99 levels for Static Shock. For Warning Tone, there are 8 types of tones and there is only frequency difference amona different types. For Vibration and Static Shock, level 1 is the lowest; level 16 is the highest for Vibration and 99 for static shock. This allows you to choose the Stimulation level that is best for your dog, Once you have placed the Receiver on your dog, it is time to find the Stimulation Level that is best for him. This is called the Recognition Level. A slight change in your dog's behavior, such as looking around in curiosity, scratching at his collar, or flicking his ears, indicates the





Risk of skin damage. Wearing a collar for too long or too tight can lead to pressure necrosis of the skin, which is often mistaken for a burn. Please follow the instructions below:

- Do not shave the dog's neck as this may increase the risk of skin irritation.
- Do not leave the Receiver on your dog's neck for continuous 12 hours. - Never attach leash to the collar.
- Never fit the Receiver too tight to your dog's neck.

2. If your dog shows no reaction, repeat the Stimulation Level several times before Q: Once my dog is trained and has been obeying my commands, will he have to continue to wear the Receiver?

- 3. YOUR DOG SHOULD NOT VOCALIZE OR PANIC WHEN RECEIVING STIMULATION. IF THIS HAPPENS, THE STIMULATION LEVEL IS TOO HIGH AND YOU NEED TO GO BACK TO THE PREVIOUS LEVEL AND REPEAT THE PROCESS.
- 4. Move up through the Stimulation Levels until your dog reliably responds to the

5. If your dog continues to show no response at highest level of Vibration or Static Shock. check the fit of the Receiver. If your dog has long or thick hair, contact our Customer Care Center to obtain a longer set of Contact Points. Then go back to #1 and repeat the process. If this still does not yield any results, your doa's hair will need to be trimmed around the Contact Points. If, after completing all of these steps, your dog still does not indicate he is feeling the stimulation, please contact our customer service.

How to maximize the distance?

Follow the steps below to find your dog's Recognition Level:

Terrain, weather, vegetation, transmission from other radio devices, and other factors will affect the maximum range.

Hold the Remote Transmitter in a horizontal position away from your body to achieve optimum range. For Maximum signal strength, keep the device properly charged.



*Avoid touching the antenna or the range may decrease substantially.

My dog does not respond when I press a button.

- Make sure the Receiver Collar has been turned on. If your range has reduced from the first time you used the Remote Training Collar.
- the battery(s) may be low in either the Remote Transmitter or Receiver Collar. Many factors can impact the amount of range you have with the Remote Trainer, For
- a list of these factors, see "How to maximize the distance?". Test the Receiver Collar. See "How to test the functions" for details.
- Increase the Stimulation Level. Refer to "How to Find the Best WarningTone" /Vibration/Static Shock Level for Your dog" for more information.
- Make sure the Receiver Collar's Contact Points are placed snugly against your dog's skin. Refer to "How to Fit the Receiver Collar" for more information.

The Receiver Collar will not turn on.

• Make sure the Receiver Collar has been charged. For the initial charge, be sure to charge it for4 hours. Subsequent charges only take 2~3 hours.

The Receiver Collar is not responding to the Remote Transmitter.

- Verify the Receiver Collar is on.
- If the indicator light is blinking rapidly, fully charged the Receiver Collar.
- If the first two solutions did not resolve your problem, see "How to pair the Remote Transmitter & Receiver Collar".
