



Lilies are one of the truly great garden plants since they are beloved by gardeners everywhere. In Chinese, the word 'lily' means 'forever in love'. The lilium family is so large, varied and complex that it is challenging to describe them in short. About This Variety: OT lilies (short for oriental-trumpet), also called orienpet or OT hybrids are crosses between oriental and trumpet lilies and withstand rough weather, late frosts, are heat tolerant and do well in a variety of garden locations. They have the fragrance and shape of an oriental lily with the strength and robustness of a trumpet type.

Growing Instructions: Plant in well-drained soil where they will receive 6-8 hours of sun a day. They are winter hardy and considered a strong perennial that can be left in the ground and will re-bloom year after year if the conditions are right. Lilies perform best when well mulched.

Care Tip: Lilies prefer cool soil. When cutting the flowers for bouquets, remove no more than 1/3 of the stem so sufficient leaves remain to renew the bulb for the coming year.

Blooms: July to August Exposure: Full Sun to Partial Shade Height: Grows 8' tall Spacing: Plant 32" apart, 8" deep USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 3-8
