RECOVER 911[™] Frequently Asked Questions

How is Recover 911 given to the flock?

Recover 911 is a water supplement mixed into the flock's drinking water. We recommend mixing one teaspoon of Recover 911 per one gallon of drinking water. For example, for a seven-gallon drinker, seven teaspoons would be used.

How often should Recover 911 be given to the birds?

We recommend providing Recover 911 at the first signs of severe stress, sickness, or during hot weather for seven consecutive days.

Can Recover 911 be used every day?

We recommend using Recover 911 only at the first signs of severe stress for seven consecutive days until the symptoms subside. For a daily digestive health maintenance, without signs of stress, we recommend using FlockLeader[™] Arrive[™] and FlockLeader Thrive.[™]

Can Recover 911 be used only with poultry of a certain age?

Nope! Recover 911 can be safely used with severely stressed poultry of any age and stage of life, including young chicks.

How many servings are in one box of Recover 911?

In one 8-oz box there are 45 servings when mixed according to the directions of using one teaspoon per one gallon of water.

What is the proper way to store Recover 911 between uses?

Recover 911 should be kept in a cool, dark place away from moisture or water sources. If there is a chance of moisture, we recommend storing in an air-tight container to keep moisture and water out.

What is the shelf life of this product?

When stored properly, in a cool dark place away from moisture, Recover 911 has a two-year shelf life.

Would Recover 911 be beneficial when isolation happens within the flock?

Yes! Isolation is a sign of severe stress! The animals who are isolating themselves should be separated from the flock, quarantined, and given Recover 911 to help with recovery and alleviate the chance of further stress or even death. In this situation, we also recommend providing Recover Plus[™] to the rest of the flock to address their potential for stress or illness, the symptoms for which may not yet have become evident.

Would Recover 911 be beneficial with lethargic birds?

Lethargy in birds is a sign of extreme stress! We recommend providing Recover 911 as soon as lethargy is identified.

Why is oregano used in this product?

At Perdue, we have been using oregano in our chicken diets for many years. Oregano is used as an antibiotic alternative. Recover 911 contains oregano and probiotics that can support a flock's health during times of severe stress.

What is animal plasma?

Animal plasma is a crucial ingredient in Recover 911 because it works in tandem with the probiotics also formulated in the product. Probiotics signal cells to initiate an immune response and plasma responds with beneficial proteins, like antibodies, to support the immune system. This dual approach is extremely beneficial to support the immune system of severely stressed, sick, and injured birds.

What are CFUs and why are they important?

CFU stands for colony-forming unit. This is a unit of measurement to determine the number of live, good bacteria (probiotics) in the product. Recover 911 contains 2 billion CFUs per serving, which ensures there is enough good bacteria being fed to the flock.

Does Recover 911 have a withdrawal period?

No. Recover 911 is a probiotic supplement, therefore it does not have a withdrawal period.

Is Recover 911 safe for all poultry species?
