

Hello Darlin® Blueberry

Vaccinium corymbosum 'FL09-216' PPAF

Fragrant blooms arrive early in spring followed by large amounts of delicious bounties of medium-sized, firm blueberries rich in flavor and antioxidants! One of the best aspects of this blueberry is its controlled, upright growth habit that matures to 4-5' H x 3-4' W. Therefore, it's easy to work into any size of landscape!

Hello Darlin™ Blueberry Care Tips

Hardy in USDA Zones 7-9, and will go dormant yearly.

Plant in Full Sun to ensure maximum foliage and berry production.

Water 2-3 times per week during the first growing season. In the second growing season, decrease watering to 1-2 times per week.

Highbush Blueberries require slightly acidic soil to thrive. Consequently, the Hello Darlin™ Blueberry won't do well in alkaline soil.

If you have alkaline soil, supplement it with elemental sulfur to decrease the pH.

How to Plant the Hello Darlin Blueberry Bush-

First, determine a suitable planting location. Then, dig a hole 3x as wide as the root ball of your plant. This makes it easier for your Blueberry to root in the surrounding soil. The hole should be deep enough that your plant will sit evenly or slightly above the ground around it. Next, mix your native soil with a bag or two of good quality garden soil or composted manure. Backfill the hole with the soil mixture around your plant. Afterward, water your new planting 2-3 times per week for the first growing season.
