How should Healthy Coop be used?

Healthy Coop can be applied liberally in the coop area, nesting boxes, and anywhere the flock travels.

How often should Healthy Coop be applied?

We recommend applying Healthy Coop once a week to help reduce bad bacteria on the ground and neutralize odor.

Can Healthy Coop be used with poultry of all ages?

Yes! Healthy Coop can be safely used with poultry of any age and stage of life, including young chicks. It is great for a flock diverse in age and species.

Why apply probiotics to the ground?

Using a probiotic in a flock's surroundings helps to reduce bacteria on the ground, in the coop and in nesting boxes to aid in a safer, cleaner external coop environment.

What if my flock pecks at it or eats it? Is it safe?

Healthy Coop is completely safe for birds to eat! This product was made knowing that when applied to the ground birds will peck and ingest a small amount. The ingredients used in Healthy Coop are safe if ingested by your flock. The probiotics used to help decrease harmful bacteria in your flock's external environment have similar effects inside the body too.

Will Healthy Coop help reduce the smell in a bird coop?

Yes! Healthy Coop will help absorb and neutralize the odor in a coop. Applying liberally once a week will help keep decrease, and may even eliminate, coop odors.

Will Healthy Coop help with an already wet coop?

Healthy Coop has moisture-absorbing properties and will help overcome wet environments that could lead to Salmonella, fungus, odor, or excessive insect outbreaks.

Is Healthy Coop safe to use if the coop litter is being composted?

Yes! Among other benefits, Healthy Coop can also help break down the waste and speed up the

composting process. If the flock is accessible to the compost pile, it also will receive the beneficial bacteria if ingested.

What is the proper way to store Healthy Coop between uses?

Healthy Coop should be kept in a cool, dark place away from moisture or water sources. If there is a chance of moisture, we recommend storing in an air-tight container to keep moisture and water out.

What is the shelf life of this product?

When stored properly, in a cool, dark place away from moisture, Healthy Coop has a two-year shelf life.

What are CFUs and why are they important?

CFU stands for colony-forming unit. This is a unit of measurement to determine the number of live, good bacteria (probiotics) in the product. Healthy Coop contains 1 billion CFUs, which ensures there is enough good bacteria to benefit the flock's external environment.

Can other FlockLeader products and Healthy Coop be used at the same time?

Absolutely! Using Healthy Coop and our FlockLeader water supplements as described ensures the flock is receiving optimum digestive health care and immune support, both internally and externally.

Is Healthy Coop safe for all poultry species?
