



How to Apply for Cats

- 1 Remove one applicator tube** from the package and hold in an upright position pointed away from your face.
- 2 Pull off cap.** Turn the cap around and place on top of the tube. Simply press cap down to break the seal of the tube. Remove cap carefully.
- 3 Position the tip** of the tube on the cat's back between the shoulder blades. Use the tip of the tube to part cat's hair so that the product will be applied at skin level.
- 4 Squeeze tube**, applying entire contents in a single spot on the cat's skin.
- 5 Separate treated cat** from dogs, cats, and other animals for 24 hours after treatment has been applied. **Repeat every month.**

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT Lyme disease in pets

- + Lyme disease is transmitted by ticks carrying the bacterium *Borrelia burgdorferi*.
- + Bacteria can affect different parts of your pet's body. Once the bacteria is in your pet's bloodstream through a tick bite, it can travel specifically to the joints or various organs.
- + Symptoms can be sneaky. Once bitten, your pet may not show symptoms for days, weeks, or even months. Some infected pets never show signs of illness. Common symptoms of Lyme disease include fevers, lameness, loss of appetite, reduced energy, swelling of joints, stiffness, discomfort, or general pain. These symptoms can progress to kidney failure, which can be fatal.
- + Lyme disease is a year-round threat. Ticks carrying the bacteria that can cause Lyme disease aren't limited to a season. Your warm, furry friend can look like a great host all year long.
- + Prevention is the most important treatment.

How to Apply for Dogs

- 1 **Remove one applicator tube** from the package and hold in an upright position pointed away from your face.
- 2 **Pull off cap.** Turn the cap around and place on top of the tube. Simply press cap down to break the seal of the tube. Remove cap carefully.
- 3 **Position the tip** of the tube on the dog's back between the shoulder blades. Use the tip of the tube to part part dog's hair so that the product will be applied at skin level.
- 4 **Begin squeezing** out the contents of the tube to form a stripe as you move from the dog's shoulder blades along the dog's back to the base of the tail.
- 5 **Repeat every month.**



Tips for Use

- + Read entire label before use.
- + Avoid touching the wet application spot.
- + Wait 24 hours to allow solution to dry before bathing or letting your pet swim.
- + Give each pet its own complete dose.
- + Use each month.
