Peach Sorbet® is a show stopper all year long! This compact blueberry is stunning with leaves that are peach, pink, orange, and emerald green. White bell-shaped flowers will appear in spring, leading to an abundant summer crop of sweet, tropical flavored blueberries. In most climates, this plant will keep its leaves throughout winter and turn a rich eggplant purple.



Zones: 5–10



Exposure: Full Sun



Size: 1½–2 feet h, Mounded



Berry Size: Medium



Fruit Season: Summer

Planting Instructions-

First, determine a suitable planting location. Then, dig a hole 3x as wide as the root ball of your plant. This makes it easier for your Blueberry to root in the surrounding soil. The hole should be deep enough that your plant will sit evenly or slightly above the ground around it. Next, mix your native soil with a bag or two of good quality garden soil or composted manure. Backfill the hole with the soil mixture around your plant. Afterward, water your new planting 2-3 times per week for the first growing season.
