## Van Zyverden's PRECHILLED PLANTED HYACINTH JAN BOS with Iron Brass Finish Bulb Planter & Stand



Forcing a hyacinth simply means to grow it indoors. They can be grown in a special shaped hyacinth glass on just water or grown in pots with soil. It is not difficult to force indoors, but but does require a little patience. You will be rewarded with color and fragrance indoors in winter when little else is in bloom.

Hyacinths have been specially treated for indoor forcing

Can be grown indoors during winter

Delightfully sweet fragrance

*About This Variety:* One hyacinth bulb, size 18/19cm, comes preplanted in a nursery pot with drainage and topped with sheet moss for a festive finish. Included is an iron polished, brass-like decorative premium planter - approximately  $4 \times 4 \times 4^{"}$  plus stand.

*Growing Instructions:* Potted, pre-chilled hyacinths bulbs will require an additional period of cooling before they will bloom. By using our pre-chilled bulbs you speed up this process. Put the entire pot in a closed plastic bag and place in the refrigerator (this puts them though a fake winter). Leave the pot in the refrigerator approximately 3 months, during which time you will see visible growth. Soil should stay moist so add a little water if needed. Take the pot out of the refrigerator and remove plastic bag. Place in a cool window to force them into bloom.

*Care Tip:* After flowering and when foliage has died, dig and clean bulbs. Store in a dry, well ventilated location. Repeat pre-chilling procedure before planting again. Hyacinths are winter hardy and resist frost damage. Contact with hyacinth bulbs may cause skin irritation. Use gloves or handle with care. Wash hands thoroughly after planting.

*Exposure:* Indirect Light

Blooms: Indoors in Winter

Height: 8-14"

Spacing: Spaced evenly in container; 1-2" apart, 1-2" deep with top 'point' of bulb exposed above soil line.

USDA Zones: Indoor forcing; Grow outdoors as Perennial in zones 4-8.
