The Coppertop Sweet Viburnum is a brilliant, bold, and beautiful new ornamental shrub from the Southern Living Plant Collection! It features glossy dark maroon-red new growth that fades to copper and then olive green over the season. Therefore, it sports a multi-toned appearance throughout much of the season. Furthermore, it also produces **small white flower clusters** with a **light fragrance** in spring.

It grows naturally upright with a bushy form and reaches 8-10 feet H x 5-6 feet W at maturity. Its foliage is surprisingly **compact and dense**, without any pruning. Therefore, this is a notably **low-maintenance** addition to your landscape.

It's perfect for a trimmed hedge, privacy screen, mass planting, or even as a specimen.

- Mulch 1-2" deep around plant, avoiding area closest to stem
