# IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS DO NOT DESTROY

- Be sure to read carefully the accompanying instruction booklet before using this bedding.
- Do not use this bedding with an infant, an immobile person, or anyone insensitive to heat, such as a person with poor blood circulation.
- Do not tuck in the wired area of this bedding.
- Do not route electrical cords between the mattress and box spring.
   Do not allow the cords to be pinched.
- Keep the control away from drafty areas that may become damp or wet such as an open window.
- 6. Do not use pins They may damage the electric wiring.
- 7. Be sure that this bedding is used on an alternating-current supply circuit of the proper voltage.
- 8. Turn off or unplug when not in use.
- Excessive heating may result from folding bedding, other than a mattress, when in actual use.
- If improper operation of this bedding is observed, discontinue its use immediately and consult the manufacturer or the dealer regarding its repair.

- Do not use with rocking chairs, recliners, chairs with casters or wheels, or other furniture subject to movement.
- 12. Do not tuck the blanket or supply cord in a sofa or other furniture. All portions of the blanket or controller should be visible at all times.
- 13. Wrapping of cord around the controller may damage the cord. Loop loosely when storing.
- 14. NOT FOR HOTEL, MOTEL OR OTHER INSTITUTIONAL USE.
- 15. This heating pad has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature. This plug will fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.



# INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the PureRelief Plush Heated Throw Blanket from Pure Enrichment. We designed this cozy throw to keep you warm while lounging in the comfort of your home. It's also great to take with you when traveling.

#### **USING PURERELIEF**

Attach the Blanket Connector to the Control Connector. Push both parts together securely to ensure a tight fit.



**NOTE:** The Control Connector must be connected to the Blanket Connector before plugging the unit into an electrical outlet.

After connecting the Blanket Connector to the Control Connector, plug the unit into a 120V AC electrical outlet.

To turn PureRelief on, press the power button. Select the desired heat setting by continuing to press the power button until the heat indicator light is the color of your desired heat setting:

Green=Warm Yellow=Low Orange=Medium Red=High

To turn PureRelief off, press the power button one more time.

**NOTE:** The "high" indicator light will blink red when an error occurs. If this happens, unplug PureRelief from the electrical outlet. Check the physical condition of the cord, the wall outlet, and the connection between the Control Connector and the Blanket Connector. If blinking persists after you confirm a proper connection, email help@pureenrichment.com.

# USING PURERELIEF (CONT'D)

**NOTE:** If the unit does not turn on when you press the power button, make sure the Control Connector is securely plugged into the Blanket Connector.

To turn PureRelief off, scroll through all the heat settings until the heat indicator light turns off.

#### **AUTO-OFF FEATURE**

To conserve energy and prevent skin burns caused by excessive use, PureRelief includes an auto-off feature. The unit will turn off automatically after two hours of continuous use. The red auto-off light will blink when this feature is activated.

**NOTE:** After a power outage, PureRelief automatically resets the timer on the auto-off feature.

#### WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

To prolong the life of your heated throw blanket, proper care and cleaning is essential. Follow these washing instructions to preserve the softness of the fabric and protect the electrical components:

- 1. Pre-soak for 15 minutes in mild soap and cold water.
- Machine wash in mild soap and cold water on slow cycle for 2 minutes.
- 3. Rinse in fresh cold water.
- 4. Spin dry.
- 5. Stretch to original size.
- 6. Do not put through a wringer.

**NOTE:** Make sure the Blanket Connector is completely dry before plugging the heating pad into an electrical outlet.
