

# Colorama™ Scarlet Crapemyrtle

*Lagerstroemia 'JMI' PP31585*

Colorful masses of scarlet-red flowers come to life on gorgeous deep green foliage from summer through fall. Vigorous, self-branching habit, reaching 15 to 20 feet tall and 8 to 12 feet wide. Excellent as a landscape specimen.

**LIGHT NEEDS** Full Sun

**USDA ZONES** 6a - 10b

**MATURE DIMENSIONS**



15–20' high x 8–12' wide

**Bloom/Feature-** Scarlet-red flowers on gorgeous deep green foliage. Vigorous; makes beautiful multi-trunked tree.

**Evergreen or Deciduous-** Deciduous- Foliage loss in winter and new growth in spring

**Plant Hardiness-** Hardy to -10°F to 0°F

**Key Features-** Attracts Birds / Butterflies, Drought Tolerance, Tolerates Clay Soil, Upright Habit

**Flowering Season-** Summer to Fall

**Uses-** Accent

**Water Needs-** Medium

**Fertilize-** Yearly in early spring

**Pruning-** Shape in early spring before first flush

## Planting Instructions

- Water before planting
- Plant in full sun
- Dig hole 2X the width of pot
- Plant 1-2" above ground soil level, backfill hole with soil
- Water deeply to settle, then add more soil if needed
- Mulch 1-2" deep around plant, avoiding area closest to stem
