#### **Indications**

NFZ<sup>™</sup> Puffer is an FDA-approved antibacterial powder administered topically for the treatment of ear and eye infections, surface wounds, cuts, and abrasions in dogs and cats.

# **Dosage and Administration**

Shake or rotate to loosen powder.

#### **Eye Infections**

Squeeze container to force a stream of powder directly into the eye. Repeat treatment daily. If no improvement after four days a new diagnosis should be made or a veterinarian consulted.

#### **Ear Infections**

Clean inside of ear and ear canal with cotton. Insert nozzle of container into ear canal and squeeze twice. Repeat daily until improvement is noted.

#### **Surface Wounds, Cuts and Abrasions**

Apply daily until danger from infection is eliminated or until healing takes place.

# **Human Warnings**

Carcinogenic: Nitrofurazone has been shown to produce mammary tumors in rats and ovarian tumors in mice. Some people may be hypersensitive to this product.

Wear gloves when applying and wash hands afterward.

# **Warnings**

For animal use only. Not for human use. Keep out of reach of children.

# **Storage**

Store at a temperature between 20°C-25°C (68°F-77°F). Avoid excessive heat (104°F) and exposure to alkaline materials.
