

Gentle Iodine Wound Spray

Indications

For use in cattle, horses, and swine as a topical antiseptic prior to surgical procedures such as castrating and tail docking; for application to the umbilical stump (navel) of newborn animals; and for minor cuts, teat sores, bruises, and abrasions.

Storage

Store at a temperature between $15^{\circ} - 30^{\circ}$ C ($59^{\circ} - 86^{\circ}$ F). Keep container tighly closed when not in use.

Ingredients

Active Ingredient:	
Titratable lodine1	.0%

Inactive Ingredients:

C9-11 ethoxylated alcohols, C10-16 ethoxylated alcohols, C12-15 ethoxylated alcohols, sodium citrate, sodium hydroxide, water.

Directions for use

Hold spray container approximately 4-6 inches from the area to be sprayed. Pull trigger of valve and spray area once lightly. May be repeated daily, if necessary, until the area is healed. Apply to the umbilical stump of newborns 2-3 times a day until the stump has dried.

When using prior to surgical procedures, allow 10 minutes contact time.

Note: When used on or near the teats or udders of dairy animals, the teats and udders should be thoroughly washed before the next milking or nursing young to prevent contamination of milk.

Caution

If redness, irritation, or swelling persists or increases, discontinue use and consult a veterinarian.

Not for use on burns, in body cavities, or in deep wounds
