







NOTICE Please retain these instructions for future reference.


- Firmly secure all bolts, screws and knobs before use.

- Fasten screws loosely during initial assembly. Do not fully tighten screws until the item is completely assembled.

- Do not use this item in a way inconsistent with the manufacturer' s instructions as this could void the product warranty.


















Attach the back panels up Part C, down Part D to the left side panel Part E and right side Part F by 4xP1 screws each side.





Put inside the wire bottom floor Part I to be **UPWARDS** in order to seperate the urine & poop.




Screw the ramp supporting board Part Q to the Part D by 2xP2 screws.

(Notice: The ramp supporting board Part Q is only assembled if you don't need the bottom wire netting)







Slide in the middle tray Part G and bottom tray Part K. 07 G Κ Screw the metal feeder Part P to the Part F by 2xP5 screws. X1 X2






Screw two casters without brake Part N to the front of hutch legs by P3x8 screws.
