



Instruction and Maintenance Guide Ashman Garden Hoe

How to Use a Garden Hoe - Instruction and Maintenance Guide

- Assembly: Ensure all bolts and nuts are securely tightened. Ensure all components are included in the packaging. Follow the manufacturer's assembly instructions carefully.
- 2. Safety Precautions: Wear appropriate safety gear, including gloves and eye protection. Be aware of your surroundings and avoid using the hoe near people or pets.
- **3.** Handle Grip: Hold the hoe handle with both hands for better control. Maintain a comfortable grip to reduce fatigue during use.
