

Japanese Maple Bloodgood

A shrub-like deciduous tree with slender airy branches. Attractive burgundy red foliage emerges during spring then turns to scarlet red in the fall. Bloodgood is a very cold hardy selection because it is late to leaf out, missing late freezes. This cultivar also grows great in high heat areas and is very sun tolerant. The color and hardiness make 'Bloodgood' a perfect addition that brings timeless beauty to any location.

USDA Zones- Thrives in 5-8

Mature Size- 15-20 feet H x 15 feet W

Deciduous- Foliage loss in winter and new growth in spring

Botanical name- *Acer palmatum* var. *atropurpureum* 'Bloodgood'

Planting Instructions

- Water before planting
- Plant in partial sun
- Dig hole 3X the width of pot
- Backfill and plant 1"-2" above soil level
- Water and add more soil if needed
- Mulch around the tree
