

Post Size	Stick Qty	Boring Depth	# of Borings
4x4, 4" Round	1	4"	1
4x6, 6x6, 6" Round	2	4"	2
3 & 4 Ply 2x6, 3 Ply 2x8	2	4"	2
8x8, 4 Ply 2x8	3	4"	3

- 1. Drill 3/8" x 4" hole on 45 degree angle extended length drill bits work best
- 2. On smaller posts, drill steeper angle so the hole terminates at the center of the post
- 3. Start first boring just above the grade line
- 4. Start the second boring on the opposite side of the post, 6" below grade

(Note: If desired, 2 sticks can be used on 4x4 and 4" round)

- 5. For posts in concrete, start borings just above grade line & slightly off center so holes don't meet
- 6. For 3 stick posts, start 3rd boring just above grade on any additional side
- 7. Laminated posts: for best results, drill borings holes through the plys
- 8. Insert Post Proservative sticks, tapered end down
- 9. Cap all boring holes with provided orange plugs
- 10. Install date tag with provided nail and punch out year of treatment
- 11. Sticks easily reloaded in original boring holes. Plug removal with 3/16" flat screwdriver
