Cattle: For the removal and control of lungworms (*Dicylocaulus vinparus*) barberpole worms (*Haemonchus contortus*); brown stomach worms (*Ostertagia ostertagi*); small stomach worms (*Trichostrongylus axei*); hookworms (*Bunostomum phlebotomum*); thread-necked intestinal worms (*Nematodirus helvetianus*); small intestinal worms (*Cooperia punctulata* and *Cooperia oncophora*); bankrupt worms (*Trichostrongylus colubriformis*); and nodular worms (*Oesophagostomum radiatum*). **Horses:** For the control of large strongyles (*Strongylus edentatus*, *S. equinus*, *S. vulgaris*, *Triodontophorus* spp.), small strongyles (*Cyanthostomum* spp., *Cylicocyclus* spp., *Cylicostephanus* spp.), pinworms (*Oxyuris equi*), and ascarids (*Parascaris equorum*).

This product has been formulated specifically for horses, lactating and non-lactating dairy cattle and beef cattle and is not intended for other species.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS:

Cattle: Feed Safe-Guard® 0.5% Crumbles (MS) at the rate of 1 pound per 1,000 pounds of bodyweight with grain and forage to supply 2.27 milligrams of Fenbendazole per pound of bodyweight. Always provide plenty of clean, fresh water.

Horses: The recommended dose is 5 mg fenbendazole per kg body weight (2.27 mg fenbendazole per pound of body weight-1 pound per 1,000 pounds of body weight) in a ONE (1) DAY treatment.

For ascarids, the recommended dose is 10 mg fenbendazole per kg body weight (4.54 mg fenbendazole per pound of body weight-2 pounds per 1,000 pounds of body weight) in a ONE (1) DAY treatment. All horses must be eating normally to ensure that each animal consumes an adequate amount of the medicated feed. Safe-Guard 0.5% Crumbles must be spread uniformly on top of the daily ration.

Regular deworming at intervals of 6 to 8 weeks may be required due to the possibility of reinfection.

WARNING: Do not use in horses intended for human consumption. Keep this and all medications out of the reach of children. Not for use in humans.

LIMITATIONS: Feed as sole ration for one day. Retreatment may be needed after 4-6 weeks. Do not use within 13 days of slaughter. No milk withdrawal. A withdrawal period has not been established for this product in pre-ruminating calves. Do not use in calves to be processed for veal. NOTE: Consult veterinarian for assistance in the diagnosis, treatment and control of parasitism.
